The Study

The Shire of Broomehill Tambellup commissioned CATALYSE® to conduct an independent MARKYT[®] Community Scorecard.

All community members were invited to take part. Scorecard invitations were sent to all households and residential PO Boxes in the Shire of Broomehill Tambellup using Australia Post's unaddressed mail services. Respondents could complete the scorecard in hard copy or online.

CATALYSE[®] sent email invitations to the Shire's customer contacts, and the Shire provided supporting promotions through its communication channels, including social media.






The scorecard was open from 26 July to 13 August 2021.

The scorecard was completed by 93 local residents and 6 Shire affiliates (councillors or staff). Resident responses were weighted by age and gender to match the ABS Census population profile.

Throughout this report, where sub-totals add to $\pm 1\%$ of the parts, this is due to rounding errors to zero decimal places.















How to read the MARKYT 📀 Benchmark Matrix

This line represents okay performance based on the MARKYT Performance Index Score. Higher performing service areas are placed above this line while lower performing areas are below it.















Important to maintain & upgrade all local roads. Maintain a local workforce & capability.

Local roads. Gravel and sealed roads need to be managed in such a way that they are addressed at the ideal time before issues arise instead of retrospectively.

More need to increase road widths and verges (gutter and suckers need clearing).

Old narrow culverts to be widened on narrow roads to allow 2 vehicles to pass safely over culverts and for the culverts on gravel roads to be maintained when grading to prevent blockages.

Pay professionals to do the roads so they might last longer.

Roads - need to be graded wider and trees stopped from growing on barriers. All pipes are blocked and broken by graders. Water runs down middle of roads.

Roads desperately need some attention and not just adding to the road which makes it un level and pulls your car into the verge. Especially when wet!!

As a user of gravel roads daily, attention needs to be made to local gravel roads, as well as drainage issues especially with the wet winter we have experienced!!

Keep roads in good condition and always improving where they can.

This is a given. It will always be a priority.

Get rid of old buildings - old houses and old shops.



Ensure that there are places for people to visit and stay as they travel the Great Southern.



"Putting money into chalets or upgrading the caravan site. Think-tank on tourism attractions and integrating the use of available local businesses and the community."








