#### **HOW DO I STAY INFORMED DUIRNG AN EMERGENCY??**

Fires can happen suddenly and change quickly, so don't rely on receiving a warning. It's your responsibility to stay informed and alert. Be flexible – get emergency information from multiple sources and never rely on any one source.

The best way to stay informed during an emergency is to seek information from a variety of sources.

You can get information by:

- using the Emergency WA website www.emergency.wa.gov.au
- staying in touch with neighbours, family, and friends
- being alert and aware of your surroundings
- following DFES on Facebook
- listening to ABC local radio, and
- tuning in to 6PR in the metropolitan area.

If someone you know tells you about a possible emergency, or if you can see or smell something that might be dangerous, that is your warning. Take immediate action to stay safe. Do not wait to receive a warning or text message.

The warnings on the Emergency WA website are also available by calling the relevant agency, for example the DFES emergency information phone line (13 DFES or 13 3337) or the Bureau of Meteorology's recoded message line 1300 815 916.

#### **BROOMEHILL HERITAGE TRAIL**

Have you walked the Broomehill Heritage Trail yet and noticed that the QR codes don't work? Well – now they



do! When scanned with a mobile device, the QR code will direct you to the Shire's website, where, in collaboration with the Broomehill Heritage Group (BHG), we have been able to upload photos and documents that were previously hidden away in the BHG's extensive collection.

#### STAY CONNECTED

Connected communities are safer communities.

Keep in contact with neighbours, friends and family, especially during high fire-risk day.

Talk to your local brigade about how to prepare for a bushfire.

#### STAY ALERT

If you can see or smell a bushfire – that's your warning.

Your surroundings could be the best source of information.

If you live in, or near bush, you need to stay alert. If there are signs of a bushfire you could be in danger. Act immediately to keep you and your family safe.

#### KEEP YOUR DETAILS UP TO DATE

A telephone warning might be sent to your mobile phone or landline in extreme circumstances. This warning system (Emergency Alert) uses the address held by your phone company.

Keep your address details up to date with your phone company to give yourself the best chance of receiving a warning if one is issued.

#### MONITOR OFFICIAL WARNINGS

During an emergency monitor what's happening. You can find bushfire alerts and warnings at:

Expressions of Interest (EOI) are sought from suitably qualified individuals to be appointed as an external member to the Council's Audit and Risk Committee (the Committee) until the October 2025 Local Government Ordinary Elections.

The Committee is responsible for reviewing and making recommendations to Council regarding financial management, risk management, internal controls, legislative compliance, internal and external audit planning and reporting.

We are seeking an individual who can not only assist with the monitoring of the Shire's governance environment, but also help to identify and drive improvement initiatives which will deliver gains to the Council, staff and the wider community. Financial management, audit acumen and/or prior experience in local government will be highly regarded.

The Local Government Act 1995 prevents the Shire from making payment to the successful applicant, however reimbursement of reasonable expenses associated with performance of the role may be provided.



# Inaugural Walkanu Art Prize Ignites the Spirit of First Nations Creativity for NAIDOC

In an exciting development for Australia's First Nations artistic community, the Goldfields Aboriginal Business Chamber is delighted to announce the launch of the inaugural Walkanu Art Prize. This competition, designed to celebrate NAIDOC Week, offers a unique platform for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander artists, who live in Australia and are aged 16 and above, to showcase their talents.

Participants are invited to submit their work across four diverse categories: 2D Art (drawings, paintings etc), 3D Art (sculptures, weaving, carvings etc), Digital Art, and Photography. Aligning with the 2024 NAIDOC theme "Keep the Fire Burning! Blak Loud and Proud," artists are encouraged to explore and express their cultural heritage, personal stories, and perspectives through their art.

The Walkanu Art Prize not only provides an opportunity for artists to gain recognition and exhibit their work in Kalgoorlie and Esperance but also offers prizes totalling \$15,000!

Moreover, the Walkanu Prize emerges as a pivotal initiative for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander economic development. 
