## YOUR RATES

# How Your Rates are Calculated

Your general rates are calculated using the valuation of your property, set by Landgate, multiplied by the Council's adopted rate in the dollar. Council's approximately 3% increase relates to total general rate revenue across the Shire and does not mean every individual rate notice will increase by 3%. Individual rates may vary depending on changes to Landgate property valuations and whether the minimum payment applies.

Properties used predominantly for non-rural purposes are rated using Gross Rental Value (GRV). Other properties are rated using Unimproved Value (UV).

### EXAMPLE

A property with a GRV of \$10,000

**\$10,000 × 8.5130 cents in the dollar =  
\$851.30 in general rates**

Where the calculated general rates are less than the minimum payment, the \$660 minimum payment applies.

Your rate notice will include ESL and rubbish charges, where applicable. These are separate from your general rates. Eligible rebates and concessions are then applied.

# Due Dates & Instalment Options

Second, third and fourth instalments will incur an administrative fee of \$10 and a daily interest on each instalment calculated at the rate of 5.5% per annum.

## Interest on Overdue Rates & Charges

Council has adopted an interest rate of 11% per annum on overdue rates and charges. Interest accrues daily on eligible amounts remaining unpaid after 4:00pm on Friday 9 October 2026.

Penalty interest does not apply where you are paying under an approved instalment plan, and each instalment is paid on time – instalment interest of 5.5% per annum applies to those amounts instead.

## Rubbish & Recycling 2026/27

Council contracts Warren Blackwood Waste to provide a weekly rubbish collection (240-litre wheelie bins) and fortnightly recycling collection within the Broomehill and Tambellup townsites.

# Your 2026/27 Budget at a Glance

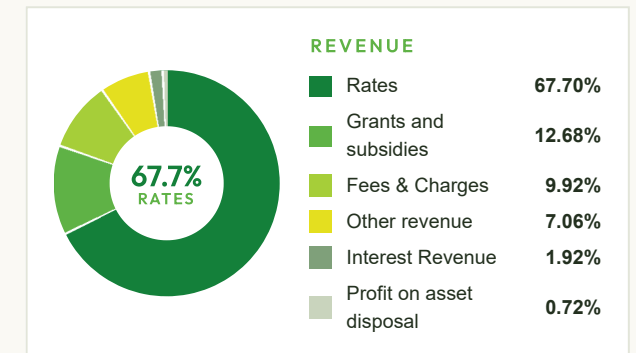
The 2026/27 Annual Budget was adopted at the August Ordinary Council Meeting.

## Key Highlights

We have limited the increase in general rate revenue to approximately 3%, while maintaining significant investment in our roads, facilities and community infrastructure – most of it funded through grants rather than rates.

## Major Investments

We have adopted a capital works program of approximately \$7.02 million for 2026/27. Around \$6.48 million is funded through grants and contributions, reserves, borrowings, and asset sale proceeds, with approximately \$543,000 funded from municipal funds. Major investments include around \$4.13 million in road construction and renewal, together with caravan park cabins, Youth Centre upgrades, water security works and fleet renewal.



## Early Payment Discount Discontinued

We have discontinued the early payment discount for 2026/27. This applies a consistent approach across all ratepayers and has helped us limit the overall rates increase for the year. We will continue to offer flexible instalment payment options to assist with managing your rates payments.
