Dear Joanne,

Re: the proposed changes to
the intersection of Nooknellup Road & Broomehill - Kojonup Road.

As ratepayers, [REDACTED] is in agreement to such changes,
on the condition you have outlined, and in accordance with the measurement on the
sketch map provided.

When I met Glen at the crossroads recently we discussed the possibility of putting
down a livestock underpass for [REDACTED] - when the Broomehill-Kojonup
Road is widened, in a year or two.

[REDACTED] has approximately 450 hectares, 18 paddocks, on the north side
of the Road [REDACTED]

When shifting sheep across the Road we require at least - 2 signs, 2 persons, and a
utility with flashing light - as this is a very busy road most of the time.

There is a certain amount of risk taking stock across the road even with all these
precautions. Even then an occasional vehicle (mainly from city) will fail to slow
down.

As you no doubt know there is now a requirement for a permit to shift even
ONE sheep across a road.

I showed Glen the possible site for a future underpass - about 50metres east of our
front gate where the road sits almost 1 metre above the side of the road.

Glen was very positive about the site and thought there would be enough funds
available to include the cost of the underpass.

I trust the Council will look at this request proactively. I think underpasses are the
future - what with litigation, and greatly increasing traffic etc.

I am sure Council would agree that it would be much more cost effective to have the
underpass built at the same time as road work is underway.
