I am writing to the council requesting they investigate, and possibly implement, putting a sheep underpass on the Broomehill-Kojonup road.

As a large part of our property is north of this road and we are a predominantly a sheep farming enterprise we are continually having to cross the road with mobs of sheep.

As you are probably aware, in the past 6 years traffic has increased greatly. We hardly move sheep across the road without having to hold up vehicles.

Unfortunately, many vehicles do not respond to the signs, ute with flashing light, dogs and people in attendance and we almost have to step in front of vehicles to stop them, which is dangerous.

I understand there is a possibility the road resurfacing is imminent as it is in such bad condition and breaking up.

This would be a good time to create a sheep tunnel under the road. I am wondering whether the council is able to access a grant for such a project.

A road traffic audit would be helpful in establishing the amount of traffic using the road.
