I am disappointed at your response regarding an underpass for our property on the Broomehill Kojonup Road especially as I received a phone call from Peter, in your employ, who said an audit was possible and I think this is very necessary

Any audit across the length of this road would give a similar result as to the number of vehicles using this road daily and other considerations.

I observe there are car counters regularly put across the road.

At present vehicle numbers are lower due to it being winter and the recent high price of fuel, but this is only temporary.

Peter also said an official was coming through to check road culverts etc and was going to contact me.

I understand the Broomehill Kojonup Road will need revamping on the Broomehill side – shoulders or complete resurfacing as the current surface is appalling and dangerous with potholes etc everywhere which you must concur with.

If the above goes ahead it would be an ideal time to put in an underpass and if it is dangerous or a 'black spot' I understand some outside finance may be available.

It is possible that in the not-too-distant future the shire may be required to compulsorily put in underpasses as on Albany Highway and other busy roads.

It is so necessarily needed that we may be able to contribute some funds financially, but to suggest we do the whole process with engineering plans etc is rather rude.

We have been crossing this road with stock [REDACTED] and you can be assured that we have put gates, crossing sites etc to the very best and safest possible advantage.

We have 2 very good sites where an underpass could be put in. One is in a gully without a culvert which regularly floods across the road with heavy rains.

I believe the shire do everything possible to pursue this action of putting in an underpass as it is very necessary. Every opportunity for a grant or financial assistance should be pursued. I don't think you should put it in the 'too hard' basket and forget about it. I certainly won't.
