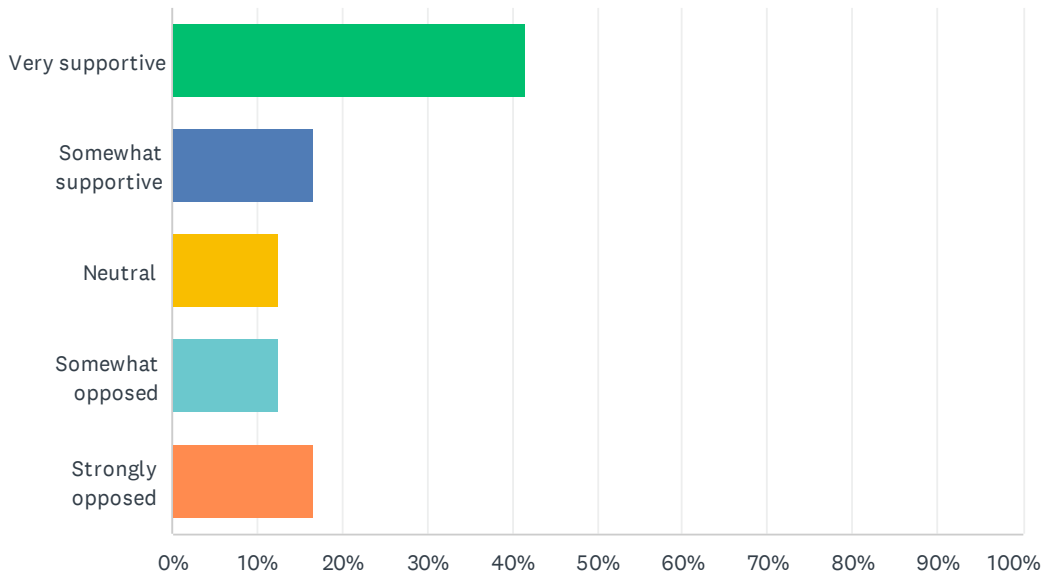


Q1 How supportive are you of the development of an off-lead dog park at the Tambellup Sports Ground?

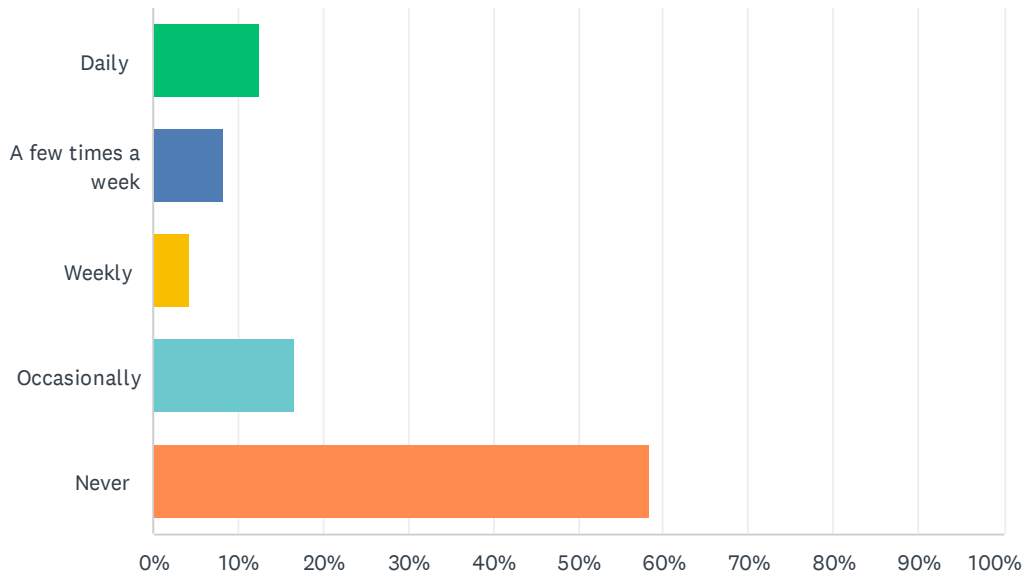

Q2 If built, how often would you visit the Tambellup Sports Ground off-lead dog park?

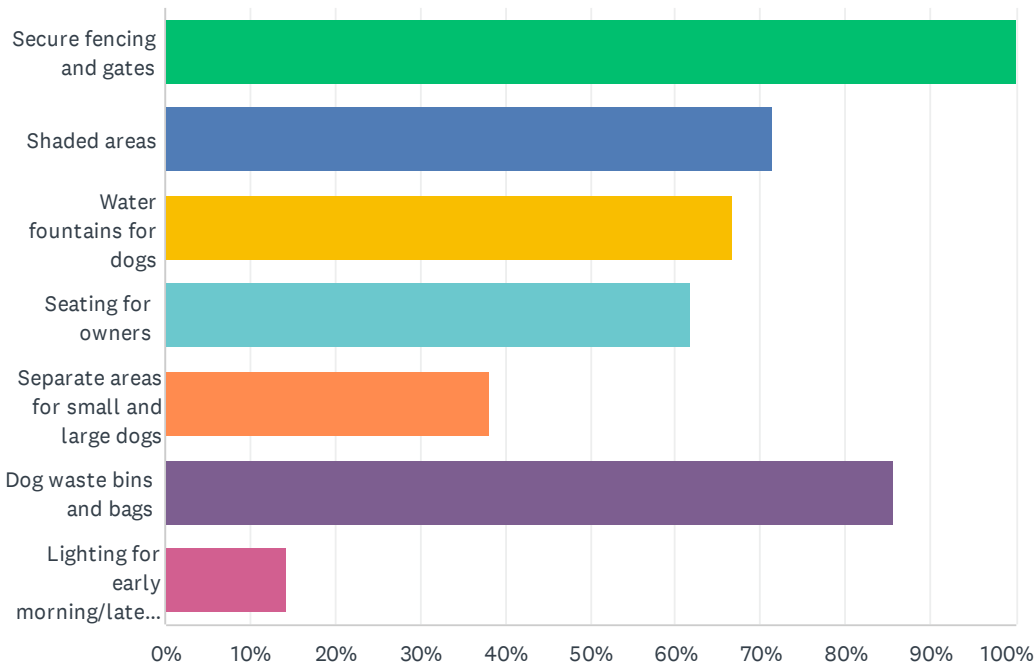

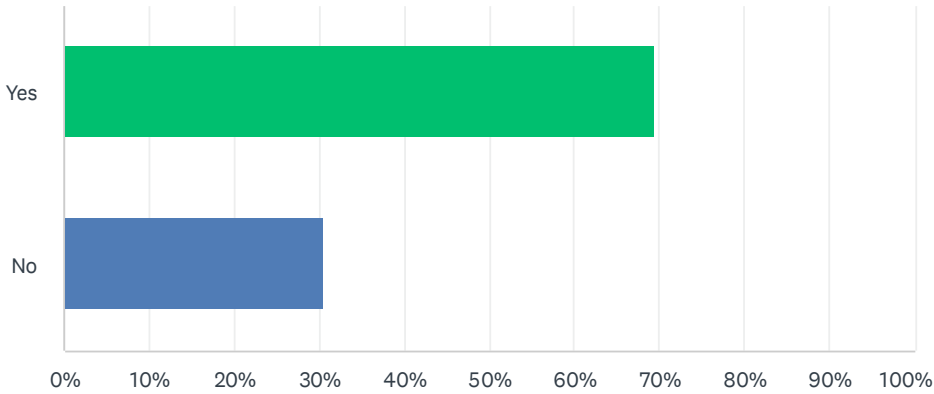
Q5 Do you have any suggestions to make the off-lead dog park safer or more enjoyable?

Q6 Do you currently own a dog?

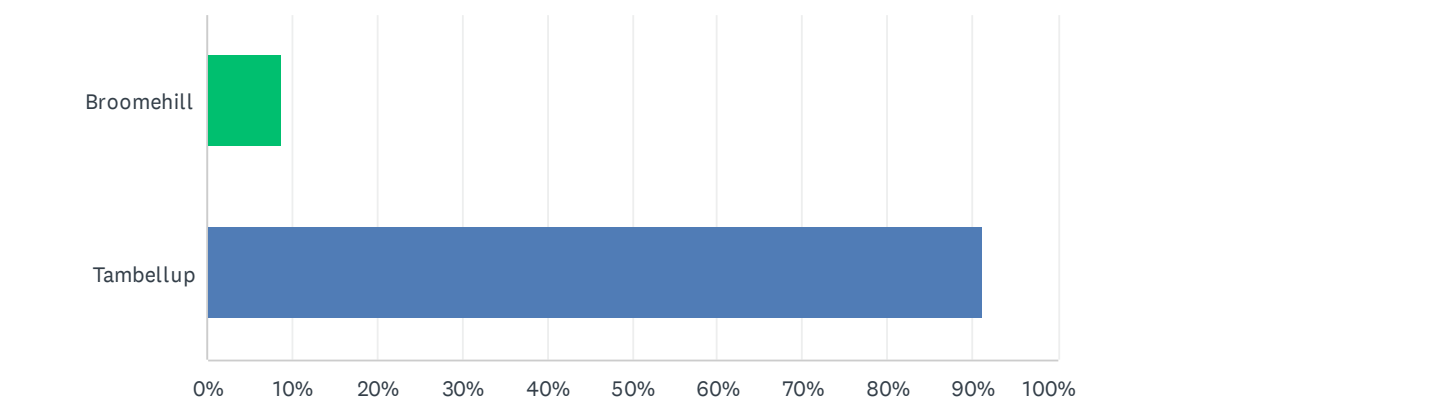
