



### TAMBELLUP SPORTS PAVILION - PROPOSED UPGRADE

Council is in the process of conducting a feasibility study to determine options for the proposed upgrade of the Tambellup Sports Pavilion. Consultants H & H Architects have been engaged to complete this process, and are working with Keston Technologies to consult with the community. Your feedback is important to the success of this project, and there are two ways to participate:

- **CALL AT EITHER SHIRE OFFICE** and pick up a copy of the survey. Completed surveys should be returned to the front counter to be forwarded on to the consultants.

The consultants will also be contacting key club and organisation representatives directly for their feedback. As the proposed upgrade will impact on all residents in the Shire, we encourage everyone to have their say. The survey is open until Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April. ### BROOMEHILL RUBBISH TIP

Council is disappointed to note the ongoing damage being inflicted on the automatic chain gate at the Broomehill Tip. The chain gate has been cut on numerous occasions to allow access, and Council staff have then been required to repair the gate.

The reason for installing the chain gate in the first instance was to ensure only local residents could access the tip, and to stop the dumping of rubbish by people from outside the shire. The intention was to prolong the life of the tip, which would minimise long term costs to ratepayers. If this behaviour continues, Council may take measures to lock the tip, and implement restricted opening hours.

### HARVEST AND VEHICLE MOVEMENT BANS

Residents are reminded the Harvest Ban Hotline number for the Shire is [98251042](tel:98251042). The service provides up-to-date information seven days a week. Harvest and Vehicle Movement bans are broadcast over ABC radio and RadioWest 1071 as they are implemented. The Shire also has in place a Harvest Ban SMS service for residents. ### WORKS

A number of road works projects are in progress in the Shire at the moment. Road works are currently in progress on Broomehill-Kojonup Rd, where widening of the next 4.5km section is being completed. From here, the crew will move over to Warrenup Rd to carry out gravel works. Contractors are also working on Tambellup West Rd pruning vegetation in preparation for the reconstruction of a 4.5km section. As always, if you are travelling in the vicinity of road works, please observe signage and drive to the conditions.

The parks and gardens crew were thankful for the rain we received during March, giving a short reprieve from the ongoing watering of gardens in both towns. A number of large trees in Crowden St have been removed as they were lifting the paving in the immediate area presenting a trip hazard to pedestrians. The paving will be re-laid and more appropriate street trees will be planted in their place. Footpath works are nearing completion in Broomehill, with contractors booked to lay asphalt in April. Work has recently commenced on the removal of the cement slab footpath in Taylor St, Tambellup, to be replaced initially with compacted gravel. It is planned that an asphalt path will be laid during the next financial year.

The maintenance graders have been working in the mid western part of the Shire.

## Southern Inland Health Initiative

### Shire of Broomehill - Tambellup Community Information

Tambellup is among the communities that will benefit from the planned capital works and health workforce improvements as part of the \$565million Southern Inland Health Initiative.

2013 will see lots of activity, as we continue to plan a raft of improvements to health care across the southern inland catchment area

#### What does this mean for the community of Tambellup?

##### New health care networks

New health care networks are being developed under the initiative. Tambellup is part of the Katanning district network. Katanning hospital will undergo a significant infrastructure upgrade as part of the \$147.4million District Hospital and Health Services Program.

As at March 2013, 18 new doctors have commenced practice in the southern inland catchment. By signing on to the Southern Inland Health Initiative, these doctors are offered attractive incentive packages, as well as a number of benefits such as an improved work/life balance and greater peer support and professional development opportunities.



In addition, there is provision to support Primary and Aboriginal health care services to Tambellup, Ongerup, Kojonup and Gnowangerup as part of the Katanning network.

Active campaigning to attract more doctors to southern inland town is ongoing.

##### Infrastructure upgrades

Getting the right mix of health services to fit community need is key to the Southern Inland Health Initiative. Extensive planning was carried out over 2011/2012 to make sure all money invested in infrastructure upgrades and refurbishments accurately reflects the health needs and priorities of individual communities – both now and in the future.

Tambellup Health Centre was one of 36 sites to undergo a Building Condition Audit. These audits have identified enabling works that will be carried out in 2013 and will provide essential facility upgrades to improve access to health services and will go towards creating a safer environment for patients and staff.

In addition, services planning workshops have been held across these sites to map out community demographics and information on the current and future health needs of the community.

Tambellup Health Centre is one of a cluster of hospitals and health centres that will share over an estimated half a million dollars of capital funds for these early enabling works. This is part of an overall investment equalling more than \$20.3million which has been invested over 2012/2013 for site specific enabling works, planning and other capital infrastructure such as Telehealth equipment across 36 sites.

It is important to note that these essential enabling or early works are the first part of an extensive infrastructure process across the southern inland catchment. Planning for the next stage of capital works across the southern inland catchment area is now underway.

### Innovative Telehealth technology

The use of Telehealth technology is the way of the future for many regional communities. New ambulatory care Telehealth equipment has been installed in Tambellup, which means people can access a range of health services from metropolitan Perth via videoconferencing.

For the Tambellup community, the means better access to health services that may not have been available in the past. This may allow people to stay closer to home when needing to access specialist medical treatment.

### Improving primary health care

Primary health care services are being strengthened under the initiative, through the development of partnerships and links between health providers from government, private, not for profit and volunteer sectors.

Primary Health Care Integration Coordinator, Raquel Willis, is working with local community members and health service providers to help develop partnerships and links between services across these sectors. This will help build the primary health care services to meet the needs of the community – including vulnerable groups such as the elderly, Aboriginal people, people from non-English speaking backgrounds and mental health support.

A partnership with Silver Chain will help improve the care for those with chronic conditions such as diabetes, asthma and heart disease. Primary Health Nurse Practitioner Shane Hourihan, will work with communities across the Central Great Southern to address these issues.


