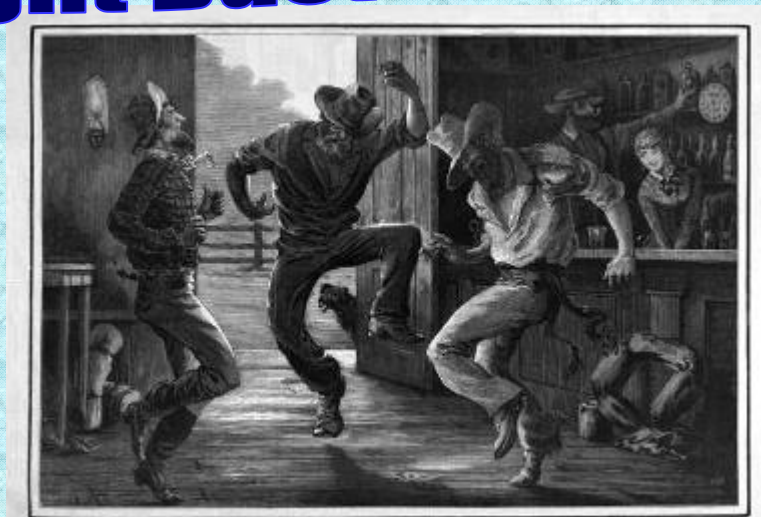

### Broomehill Historical Notes

Quite a few years ago Shirley MacDonald began to work through the diaries of her Grandfather, Thomas Norrish (TN) which he wrote when he first came to Eticup to take up farming and the diaries of William Henry Graham (WHG) who was also one of the first pioneers of the Eticup district. Shirley collated all the information both in alphabetical and chronological order. There are many wonderful pieces of information and anecdotes in these diaries and we are proud to share them with the community each month.

**Pegg or Peggy** – On 2<sup>nd</sup> December 1883, part-Aboriginal Pegg came from Martinup to see about rams for Henry Quartermaine. On 27<sup>th</sup> April 1884, Peggy was at Sunnyside with James Treasure to get tobacco. This man could have been Peg, one of three teamsters whose photograph is held in the Museum.

**Permain** – Had a blacksmith shop or employed a blacksmith. On 22<sup>nd</sup> November 1892, TN and his son George brought their reaping machine back to Goblup from Broome Hill. Paid Permain £1.5.0. On 24<sup>th</sup> January 1893, Permain's blacksmith from Broome Hill dug a hole in the hill in Sunnyside paddock looking for water. Good water was found next day.

**Perry, probably Charles** – In March 1892, Perry was sinking a tank for TN on the pother side of Boylup and in May TN saw him about doing some fencing at Goblup. On 8<sup>th</sup> June TN laid out the garden for fruit trees for Perry to fence and Perry came in on 23<sup>rd</sup> July to start the work. On 27<sup>th</sup> August TN settled with him for the garden fence and for repairs to Maher's paddock - £61.18.2. In October 1892, Perry was a member of the Goblup shearing team. On 19<sup>th</sup> July 1895, Charles Perry called at Goblup and TN let him have a packet of dynamite caps.

**Philanthropy** – On 9<sup>th</sup> October 1879, and 6<sup>th</sup> October 1881, old James Egan came to Goblup to gather money for his keep. On 8<sup>th</sup> October, a blind man was at Goblup to see what the men would give him. Of interest are the dates of these visits – during shearing when ten or more additional men would have been at Goblup. Catholic Priest Father Mateu called at Goblup on 26<sup>th</sup> October 1882 and the men gave him £3.1.0.0. On 9<sup>th</sup> June 1886, a man with bad eyes came to Sunnyside. He had a paper asking for money, saying that if he had the money he could undergo an operation.

### UPCOMING TOWNSCAPE PROJECTS

Council has recently been advised of a number of successful funding applications for townscape projects in Broomehill and Tambellup.

Funds were secured to have concept plans drawn to establish a 'Heritage Precinct' in the Broomehill town centre. This area is bounded by Journal St, India St, Ivy St and the Great Southern Highway, including Holland Park, with the project brief including streetscape works and heritage interpretation to recognise the stories of Broomehill. Lynne Farrow and Juliet Albany have been commissioned to draft the plans, and a small committee has been formed to steer the initial stage of this project.

The committee met recently to view the first draft of the plans, and were impressed by many of the ideas presented by Lynne and Juliet. The plans will be reviewed by Council in June, before being displayed at the Broomehill Shire office for public comment. The community will be advised when the plans are available, and we welcome your feedback.

An application to the Great Southern Development Commissions Royalties for Regions Town Centre Enhancement Program was successful. This project involves enhancing the area near the Railway tank in Tambellup, to include a gazebo, picnic setting, landscaping, new street furniture and a 'welcome' feature at the corner of Gnowangerup - Tambellup Rd and Great Southern Highway. With the public toilets at that end of the street being well used by travellers, it is hoped the beautification of these areas may entice people to stop in town for a little longer and utilise local businesses and services.

The 'welcome' feature, which will incorporate a mosaic wall, was an initiative of a local resident, and we are planning to invite community members to assist with this part of the project. If you are interested in being involved, please contact Pam at the Shire.

The third townscape project, through the Federal Government's Regional and Local Community Infrastructure Program, will see the gazebos at the Gordon River weir replaced. The current gazebos will be removed, and the area cleaned up before installing a new gazebo, tables and seats. Many people are observed spending time in this area, and the refurbishment of facilities will provide more pleasant surroundings.

**So, watch this space - or rather, these spaces for future developments!**

### From the Shire President

I am delighted to see the shire receive a good opening rain with the promise of follow up rains and although it doesn't solve all our problems, it is a positive start to the season and gives renewed optimism to the region.

On the never ending reform issue, there has been a development at a state level with yet another forum attended by the CEO and myself that seemed to lack any direction or result in any new or practical solutions. Following this forum a statement was issued by the Minister for Local Government, the Hon. John Castrilli that he had "drawn a line in the sand", will not be allocating any new funds for amalgamations and has abandoned the push for "voluntary" amalgamations.

On face value it may sound a done deal and the end to the reform issue, but the words which followed, "for this term of government", I think point the way forward for the government. I think we all can read into that a variety of scenarios:

- (a) Retain status quo;
- (b) A change of government may lead to a change in policy, but Labor has no formal policy yet. On the plus side they are talking to local government, including us before they set their policy going into a election year;
- (c) What I believe is most likely to occur, is that governments recognize that amalgamations are never going to occur on the scale they would like, and they follow the line of forced amalgamations with the matter being taken out of our hands. Whatever happens we can be assured that it will not be business as usual and reform of some scale will happen. Council's position has not changed - we support the voluntary amalgamation of councils with all willing partners, with the community having the final say, and we support regional partnerships such as our Voluntary Regional Organization of Councils (VROC). In our case, Broomehill-Tambellup partners with Kojonup, Cranbrook and Plantagenet to form our group.

Our VROC is working well with major projects such as a joint regional repository for archiving documents planned for the Broomehill office, joint waste disposal projects to maximize the life of our rubbish sites into the future, and the well aged care facility in Tambellup getting closer to the go ahead stage. As well as the big projects we cooperate with shared staff and services to improve efficiencies and lower costs.

On another matter, Local Government elections are close with vacancies being declared later in the year and the election to be held in October. If you are interested, now is the time to think about placing your name in the ballot. Information packs will be available as the time gets closer but until then, if you wish to discuss anything about what is involved, all councilors and the CEO are able to give information that may help you make that decision.

Local government is run by local people and is the most accountable tier of government, being so close to the community, and understands local issues as well as the broader picture. However it needs people to put their names forward to best represent the interests of the community, so I encourage you to give it some thought
