FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING

Council endorsed a review of Part 1 of the Shire's Policy Manual. The Shire's adopted policies have been made to facilitate consistency and equity in decision making; promptness in responding to customer needs; and operational efficiency. Policies are reviewed once every three years, or as required due to legislative change.

A number of amendments were made that had arisen from the recent review of the *Local Government Act*. Council also determined that *Policy 1.2 Use of Shire Facilities* should be amended to provide the following user groups with use of facilities at no charge:

- Broomehill and Tambellup Primary Schools and P & C Associations – use of Town Halls for End of Year Presentation Nights and fundraising activities;
- Broomehill religious organisations - hire of tables and chairs for Christmas Eve church services;
- Broomehill Heritage Group - hire of tables and chairs for Carols by Candlelight.

Council received the Corporate Business Plan 2018-2022 Quarterly Progress Report for the period July-September



2020. A summary of progress is shown below:

Council considered and endorsed the outcomes of the CEO's performance review, which was completed with the assistance of a consultant.

STAFF UPDATE

We were sorry to learn in October that due to family commitments, Jacki Harmer would not be continuing in the role of Trainee Youth Worker. Jacki spent five weeks in this role, and proved to be extremely capable. We wish Jacki well in her future endeavours. The opportunity will now be taken to liaise with the funding providers and stakeholders, and reassess the requirements of the position.

We also farewelled our Technical Officer, Josh Ford, during October. Josh was with the Shire for 8 years, starting in plant operation and then taking on the challenge of the Tech Officer position. Josh leaves us to further develop his career in civil construction, and we wish him well.

WORKS

During October, the construction crew continued work on the Toolbrunup Road where a 3.5km section is being repaired and resealed. The project is 50% complete, with culverts and road surface widened and gravel sheeting now in progress. The maintenance graders have been working on the following roads: Heron Rd, Norrish Rd, Laveter St, Marshall Rd, Curnow Rd, Tieline North Rd, Thompson Rd, Graham Rd, Fletcher Rd, Hillman Rd, Winspear Rd, Holland Track, Rae Rd, Paul Valley Rd, Brown Rd.

Spring time is ideal for maintenance of turf, and as such, both ovals have been cored, fertilized and treated for black beetles. Repairs have been completed on our water transfer systems, with the solar pumping system at the CBH dam now working well to transfer water to the Complex dam, and the transfer pump at the Complex dam also repaired. The solar pump at the Jam Creek dam has also been repaired.

DROUGHT COMMUNITIES PROGRAM – AMENDED CONCEPT PLANS

As previously advised, Council is eligible to receive \$1 million in grant funding through the Drought Communities Program. This funding, targeted at economic stimulus rather than drought resilience, offers the opportunity to undertake development identified in our Strategies and long term planning that currently remain unbudgeted.

Using our Strategic Community Plan as the driver, and after further community consultation, a number of projects have been identified in Broomehill and Tambellup. Listed below, these projects offer a unique opportunity to improve the amenity and impression of both towns:

The concept plans for the Broomehill and Tambellup town centre upgrades were provided to the community for comment earlier in the year. The feedback that was received was considered by Council, and the concepts have been amended, to incorporate the following:

Broomehill:

- Include additional option for Holland Track Interpretive Centre (adjacent to Tourist Information Bay)

Tambellup:

- Include provision for extra street parking both sides of Norrish St
- Amend plans to account for railway station platform
- Change location of bus bay to opposite Bank/Post Office
- Consolidate smaller lawn areas into one

The revised concept plans are available at the Shire Offices and on the Shire's website for review and we invite your feedback once again. Comments should be in writing and submitted to the Chief Executive Officer, Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup, 46-48 Norrish St Tambellup 6320, or emailed to mail@shirebt.wa.gov.au. Feedback should be received by Friday 27 November 2020.

A number of concerns were raised during the previous consultation period regarding the proposed location of the water play park within the Tambellup town centre upgrade. Currently this element of the project is unfunded and it has been included in the concepts at this time as a 'placeholder'. When funding is confirmed we will consult further with the community to establish a preferred location.

We are still waiting for Ministerial approval for our application, and are also very aware of the need to complete all works by 30 June 2021. We anticipate a very busy start to 2021 – watch that space!

All residents are advised the **PROHIBITED** burning period commences on **1 NOVEMBER 2020**. No burning is permitted from this date until **14 FEBRUARY 2021**.

The WALGA RoadWise 'Road Ribbon for Road Safety' campaign is back again in 2020. The campaign, which commences on Sunday 15 November and runs through until the end of the Christmas and New Year period, is a community-based initiative which enables everyone to directly contribute to road safety and work towards achieving zero deaths and serious injuries on our roads.

The campaign also supports the United Nations endorsed, World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims, which is dedicated to remembering those who have been killed or seriously injured on our roads. The WALGA RoadWise Road Ribbon for Road Safety® campaign aims to contribute to the long-term vision of Western Australia's road safety strategy, which follows the globally-recognised safe system approach to achieve the long-term vision of a road transport system where crashes resulting in death or serious injury are virtually eliminated.

By adopting this approach, Western Australia is following world leaders in road safety, such as Sweden and their road safety strategy, Vision Zero1. Like Sweden's Vision Zero, the philosophy of WA's road safety strategy is that the loss of human life in a traffic crash is unacceptable.

Creating a safe system requires a holistic view of the road transport system by seeking to manage the interaction between road users, roads and roadsides, travel speeds and vehicles. Road authorities, designers and engineers are responsible for creating a forgiving road system that protects and caters for the mistakes of road users, and a holistic infrastructure system. Road users are responsible for complying with all road rules and can campaign for a safe system.

UPDATE FROM THE TAMBELLUP POLICE



Hello,

Last month Tambellup Police worked closely with Cranbrook Police and Gnowangerup Police conducting road policing operations. All police stations surrounding Tambellup have seen depleted numbers for various reasons (leave/relieving), and my off-sider Senior Constable Rob ADAMCZYK has been the Acting Sergeant at Corrigin for the past month and is set to be for at least all of November. I'm on annual leave for one week in

November, which will likely force the Tambellup Police Station to close. If you need to contact police relating to a Tambellup or Broomehill matter please call 000 in an emergency, 131 444 or Albany Police on 9892 9300, and assistance will be sought from elsewhere.

Please see below some tips to help you become BUGLAR AWARE –

- Keep doors and windows locked at all times, even when at home, including sheds and garages.
- Keep valuable items such as laptops, mobile phones, and other electronic devices out of sight.
- Install a security alarm with visible external light and always turn it on.
- Do not keep spare keys hidden outside, leave it with a friend/neighbour/relative.
- Arrange for mail to be held by Australia Post or collected daily by someone while you're away.
- Be mindful of stating whereabouts on social media.
- Install motion sensor lights to the exterior of your property.
- Keep trees and shrubs trimmed to reduce the opportunity for burglars to hide and increase visibility from the street.
- Engrave/mark your property with your driver's licence number for easy identification.
- Destroy boxes from newly bought appliances such as TV's and DVD players so they are not on display for burglars to see.
- Strongly consider the installation of CCTV at your property.

If you are the victim of a home burglary please call police on 131444.

The weather has just started to warm up so please be fully aware of the risk that fire poses in our area. If you notice any suspicious behaviour possibly relating to arson, contact police immediately.

I've kept it short and sharp this month as there isn't too much to report on.

I really hope your hay fever hasn't been as bad as mine recently....



Are you a traceability ace?

Stock traceability is the first step in good biosecurity and is a key part of everyday sound farm management practices. Traceability is essential to maintain access to export markets and for food safety. It allows stock to be traced for disease or residue purposes and deters stock theft.

How are animals traced?

If you own cattle or other livestock, you must register as an owner of livestock, identify stock correctly, obtain a property identification code (PIC) for each property where you keep them and record movements to your property on the National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) database.

Cattle must have a registered identifier (brand and/or earmark) and an NLIS electronic device that enables animals to be tracked from property of birth to slaughter or export.

Don't break WA's livestock traceability chain

A weak link can break traceability and cost you market access.

Cattle Industry Funding Scheme

Are your cattle registered to your property?

The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (DPIRD) find that half of all traceability non-compliance issues involve cattle that are not registered to the PIC they are leaving from. This breaks our traceability chain, is a potential biosecurity and market risk and can also hold up processing at the abattoir.

Don't get caught out!

Now - and not when loading the truck - is the time to check that your cattle are registered to your property by using an NLIS scanner. Scan the tags and DPIRD can assist you to run a check on the NLIS database and to update any missing movements.

If you do not have a scanner, they are easy to use and available to loan from DPIRD Katanning and Katanning Community Resource Centre or by contacting **1300 WA NLIS (1300 926 547)**, or email nlis@dpiird.wa.gov.au. Further information is available on agric.wa.gov.au/livestock-movement-ID
