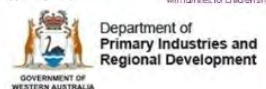

Members of the public are welcome to attend all Council meetings, however social distancing requirements limit the number of people able to be present. FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING

- Council determined that the Council elections to be held in October 2021 would be conducted by the Electoral Commission as a postal election. More information will be available in coming months.
- Council considered the review of the Shire's Local Laws which has recently been completed, and resolved to adopt the existing Local Laws with minor amendments. Council also adopted a new Bush Fire Brigade Local Law. These are required to be submitted for publishing in the Government Gazette. Following that process, the new Local Laws will be available on the Shire's website.
- Council considered and endorsed a review of Part 2 of the Policy Manual. Council Policies are required to be reviewed at least once in every three years, and staff are presenting the review in parts to each Council meeting.

Council received the quarterly Progress Report for the Corporate Business Plan 2018-2022, for the period October-December 2020. Detail of progress is available in the attachments to the minutes of the February Council meeting <https://www.shirebt.wa.gov.au/council-meetings/ordinary-council-meeting/11-february-2021-ordinary-meeting-of-council/153>. A summary of progress is shown below:



- Council considered and approved a request to remove the Section 70A Notification from the title of Lot 547 Tieline Road, Broomehill, to allow persons other than family members to occupy ancillary accommodation.
- Council considered and approved a development application for a shed on Lot 386 (No 9) Spencer Road, Broomehill subject to conditions.
- Council considered and approved a development application for a single dwelling on Lot 3 (No 503) Pallinup Road, Broomehill subject to conditions.
- Council approved the development of a Memorandum of Understanding by the CEO, to allow internet provider Superloop to lease the Shire's telecommunications assets located at 1245 Jam Creek Road, Dartnall.
- Council approved the membership request of the Shire of Gnowangerup and the Shire of Katanning to become full members of the Southern Link Voluntary Organisation of Councils, and welcomes these new member Local Governments to the VROC.
- Council discussed a proposal to seek funding through the Building Better Regions Fund for the development of the Broomehill Caravan Park and proposed Tambellup Caravan Park. Cr Paganoni and Cr Penny voted against the recommendation, due to the requirement for further information and consultation regarding the Broomehill proposal. Council authorised the submission of a grant application, however further consultation will be undertaken with the Broomehill Cooperative.

RESIDENT FEEDBACK, QUERIES AND REQUESTS OF THE SHIRE – COMMUNICATION CHANNELS

All residents and community organisations are reminded that any requests for works or information, or feedback on issues with community facilities should be made through the correct channels – that is, through the front counter at both offices. This ensures that all relevant information can be obtained and recorded at the time, and then passed on to the appropriate person for actioning. Adherence to this process will ensure we are able to respond and communicate outcomes to you. Please do not contact staff members directly in the first instance. WORKS REPORT

There was some new toy excitement at the Depot during February, with the delivery of the new Cat 140 Grader and a new Cat 444 Backhoe loader, as per Council's Ten Year Plant Replacement Program. Works staff have been inducted into the use of these two machines.

The Black Spot funded realignment of the Flat Rocks Rd/Greenhills South Rd/Brassey Rd intersection is underway, with construction being completed and ready for stabilising and sealing. This will be carried out over the first two weeks in March. People travelling in the area are asked to exercise caution and observe all signage in place.

Water levels in the Shire's dam network are being carefully monitored, with pumping systems being maintained to ensure all water is able to be transferred when it arrives. In Broomehill, the storm system that passed through mid-February filled the CBH dam, and we are in the process of transferring this to the Complex Dam. The Town Dam is currently 80% full, and the Complex Dam is at 50%, with the Bignell dam 2/3 full. This is being transferred to the Complex Dam. In Tambellup Water Corporation reuse water system is currently being utilised at the Tambellup oval as per Health Department and Water Corporation guidelines, and dams are extremely low. The rain during February has assisted in greening the surface but more rain is required for the catchment.

Maintenance grading has been completed on the following roads: Flat Rocks Rd, Pallinup Rd, Brassey Rd, Beejenup Rd, Collins Rd, Paul Valley Rd, Toolbrunup Rd, Crosby Rd, Bessen Rd, Burrridge Rd, Johnston Rd, Peter Valley Rd, Monies Hill Rd, Witham Rd, Anderson Rd, Batchelor Rd, Tallents Rd.

IT'S STILL BUSHFIRE SEASON

The **RESTRICTED** burning period applies from **15 FEBRUARY 2021** until **15 APRIL 2021**. Residents are required to obtain a **PERMIT TO BURN** prior to lighting any fires during this period. Permits can be obtained from your Brigade Fire Control Officer as noted below.

March can present challenging conditions for our volunteer brigades, with extremes of weather the norm. Please remain vigilant when working outdoors, or with anything that may cause a fire.

HARVEST AND VEHICLE MOVEMENT BANS

While harvest is finished, the dry conditions are still with us. Here's a reminder about how you can keep track of Harvest and Vehicle Movement Bans in the Shire:

- **Harvest Ban Hotline – phone 98251042.** This service is maintained by the Shire and fire control officers 24/7, and provides the most reliable and up to date source of information.
- **Text messaging** - Council offers a service to residents whereby you can receive notification of harvest bans and road closures by SMS. **If you are currently registered for this service, it would be appreciated if you could contact Lesley or Sam at the Shire on 98253555 to ensure your details are correct.** Similarly, if you would like to register, or no longer wish to receive these notifications, please contact the Shire.
- **Radio broadcasts** – ABC radio, as the emergency broadcaster, provides updates of harvest and vehicle movement bans at scheduled times through the day (10.15am, 12.15pm, 2.15pm). While every effort is made to ensure this information is available by broadcast times, changing weather conditions mean this is not always possible. Please do not rely on ABC or other radio stations as a single source of information.
- **Contact your Brigade Fire Control Officer** – contact details are noted above.
- **And if all else fails** – make a judgement call and stop work if you think conditions have deteriorated!

EMERGENCY WA

Emergency WA (www.emergency.wa.gov.au) is the State's official website for community warnings and other emergency management information for bushfires, storms, cyclones, floods and other emergency situations. The site provides real time updates on emergency warnings and incidents across the state, as well as information on preparing and recovering from an emergency situation. One to bookmark!

ANNUAL AUDIT AND ANNUAL ELECTORS MEETING

Council's audit report has been submitted to the Office of the Auditor General for assessment. Due to amendments to financial management regulations in late 2020 there has been a delay in assessment of audit reports across the local government sector. This has delayed Council's ability to schedule the Annual Electors Meeting.

Council's auditor has advised that the audit process should be finalised soon, and the audit report returned to Council for adoption. Once the audit report is returned to Council it will be presented for adoption. An Annual Electors Meeting will then be scheduled in accordance with the Act.

Exact timeframes cannot be confirmed, however, it is hoped that the Annual Electors Meeting will be scheduled for late March or early April.

UPDATE FROM THE TAMBELLUP POLICE

Hello,



We recently had a few issues with hoon driving in Broomehill Village. The driver also drove recklessly in the vicinity of the Broomehill Primary School. This behaviour is obviously unacceptable and something we do not tolerate or allow any leniency for. The vehicle involved was subsequently seized and the driver is facing charges in relation to the matter.

Tragically there have been eight fatalities on Great Southern Roads in as many weeks! Please have a continual safe approach to driving in our region. These numbers are completely devastating for the families and everyone else involved. Remember **DO NOT DRIVE TIRED, DO NOT BE DISTRACTED BY YOUR PHONE (WHICH YOU SHOULDN'T BE TOUCHING OR HAVE RESTING ON YOUR KNEE – HEAVY PENALTY IF CAUGHT), DO NOT DRIVE HAVING CONSUMED ALCOHOL OVER THE LEGAL LIMIT.** You shouldn't have prohibited drugs in your system and if you're test positive you will lose your licence. Contrary to what some people think, any reading of cannabis is illegal – it's an illegal drug.

New legislation came in on 26 Jan, whereby a Prohibition Notice (PN) can be served – The PN enables officers to immediately prohibit a driver from driving for 24 hours when they are found to have a prescribed illicit drug present in their oral fluid; are deemed incapable to undergo a confirmatory test; two confirmatory tests have failed; or they refuse to comply. The PN makes it unlawful for a person to drive on a road for 24 hours, however, the notice has no effect on the person's driver's licence. Penalties apply for a driver who contravenes a PN, with secondary and subsequent offences receiving a higher penalty. Normally if someone tests positive for drugs the formal test will be sent to the ChemCentre for confirmation, and a loss of licence doesn't occur until confirmation is received by the testing officer. This new legislation cancels the person from driving for an immediate period of 24 hours. If someone breaches the PN they can be arrested and charged.

A burglary occurred just outside of Broomehill Village between 17 and 19 Feb, whereby a large blue GMC air compressor was reported stolen. Anyone with information in relation to the burglary is urged to call crime stoppers on 1800 333 000 or Tambellup Police on 9854 9800. Following on from this, I'd like to remind everyone to secure their properties to make it hard for crooks. Lock doors and windows, padlock gates if away for an extended period, notify neighbours or relatives/friends requesting they keep an eye out. A combination of overt and covert CCTV cameras is a great approach, with regard to capturing evidence and deterring crooks who want to enter and steal. If you make it difficult for the crooks, they'll more often than not try the next place. Please report any suspicious activity, people descriptions, vehicle regos and the like to us. This helps us to keep a track of what's occurring and to focus our patrols on the area/s being targeted.

I'm pleased to inform you that the Tambellup Police Station Mural project is progressing in the background. Funding for the project has been secured from the local Bendigo Bank, thank you to Bank Manager Steve and the board for this, we very much appreciate it. Approval has very recently been received for Pardelup Prison to come and render the wall in preparation for the mural. Thank you also to Shire CEO Keith and the Broomehill Tambellup Shire for providing a load of sand and a few bags of cement to make this happen!! On the day of the mural being painted all members of the community will be welcome to come and watch or to get involved with the painting. I will share plans for the day and the final design with the community soon.

Critical Information For Bushfire Brigade Members When Responding To Fires

All units attending bushfires are asked to switch to CH 5 and use this for fire communications, this is to make sure that you are aware of all the information being circulated on the fire ground.

Such information could include general weather updates with changing wind directions, notification to move away from the fires edge due to Water Bombers wanting to make a drop, or that the fire has escaped on one of the flanks and further resources are required in that location.

Being on CH 5 will assist with bringing the fire under control sooner in many instances as the information is being distributed to everyone on the fire ground.

For your safety and protection we ask that bushfire PPE is worn on the fire ground when attending a fire.

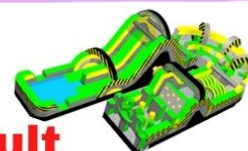

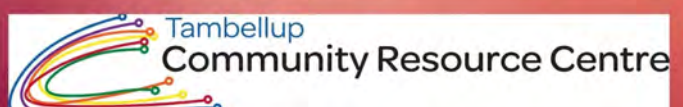

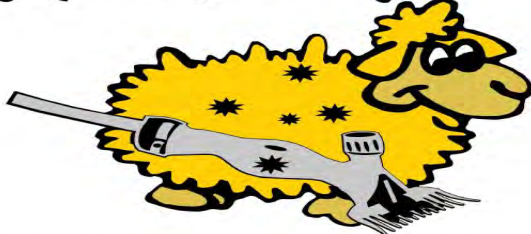
