FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING

It was with regret that the Shire President accepted the Chief Executive Officer's notice of resignation prior to the June Council meeting. Keith has accepted a position at the Shire of Broome and will be finishing at the Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup at the end of August. Council will now commence a recruitment process to fill the CEO vacancy, with assistance provided by recruitment agency Lo-Go Appointments.

Council considered and approved a request for a financial contribution of \$500 towards the purchase of netball uniforms to enable four teams from Tambellup to attend the NAIDOC Netball carnival in Perth during July. We wish the participants every success at the carnival, and look forward to photos of Tambellup representation at its best!

Council resolved to enter into a Service Agreement with Great Southern Centre for Outdoor Recreation Excellence (GSCORE) for a further two year period, to continue the implementation of the Great Southern Regional Trails Master Plan. In Broomehill and Tambellup, the trails included in the plan are Boot Rock Reserve, the walk section of the Holland Track, and the Tambellup Heritage Trail. Council also supported a request for a contribution of \$1000 towards the branding strategy development for all trails nominated in the Master Plan.

WORKS REPORT

Work has continued on construction jobs funded through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program Round 1 during June, including culvert widening and gravel sheeting on Etna Road, gravel sheeting of 2 km of Birt Road and kerbing replacement in the townsites (this work was interrupted by rain and contractors will return in coming weeks). Upcoming works include gravel sheeting on various sections of Nymbup Road, Paul Valley Road and Beejenup Road. A contract grader and roller has been engaged to assist with the construction program associated with the Local Roads gravel sheeting projects. The intersection of Greenhills South Rd and Etna Rd has been improved, with gravel resheeting and culvert widening. 300m3 of sand has been brought in to the Broomehill Recreational Complex, for the sand pad for the new Cricket Pavilion.

We were fortunate that the storm which hit the region late in June causing significant flooding and damage to roads in Albany and Denmark was not as severe in our area. Gravel roads were closed to heavy vehicles for a period following the rain as a precautionary measure to minimise the risk of damage to the road

network, and the maintenance team spent some time clearing fallen trees and branches, however no significant damage was reported.

New town centre and directional signage has been installed, and pot hole patching and replacement of guideposts across the Shire has continued. Maintenance grading has been completed on the following roads in June: Pallinup Rd, Heron Rd, Norrish Rd, Etna Rd, Gillespie Rd, Martinup Rd, Tieline North Rd, Marshall Rd, Curnow Rd, Graham Rd, Fletcher Rd, Winspear Rd, Witham Rd.

June rains have been beneficial for Shire dams, with the Broomehill Town dam and CBH dams full, Broomehill Complex dam at 70% and the Jam Creek Rd dams at 75% capacity. All pumping systems are working well, and advice is being sought on the efficiency of the solar systems in place at the dams.

LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

At the June meeting of the LEMC, the committee discussed the Shire's proposal to establish a Contiguous Local Authorities Group for the purpose of mosquito control in the Shires of Broomehill-Tambellup, Gnowangerup and Katanning. This proposal, if successful, may see information and funding being made available about options for the treatment of mosquitoes. The proposal requires evidence of need, and specifically of instances of Ross River Virus being contracted in our area, and at this point the Department of Health has indicated it is not aware that there is a significant issue.

We would be interested in hearing from anyone in the Shire who lives locally and has contracted Ross River Virus, to support our case for the establishment of this group. All information provided will be treated confidentially. For more information please contact the CEO on 9825 3555.

HAVE YOU NOTICED A FAULTY STREET LIGHT IN YOUR STREET?

Western power has improved the online reporting process, with the following features:

- A new and improved streetlight map that's much easier to use
- Real time information on which streetlights have already been reported (the map will indicate this when you select a streetlight)

Option to receive updates on our progress via email/SMS (simply select your contact preference when submitting your report)

If you see a fault, report it straight away. Please refrain from keeping a list of faults and reporting them at a later date, as one of the faults may have already been resolved and this may cause unnecessary callouts. If the streetlight is damaged or fallen, or if you think it might be dangerous, please call **13 13 51** straight away.

WASTE TRANSFER STATION – PRE PAID TIP CARDS

Residents are reminded that the blue 2020-2021 Waste Transfer Station passes expire on 31 July 2021, and will not be accepted after that date. New passes valid for 2021-2022 will be distributed with rates notices for those residents who do not receive the kerbside rubbish and recycling collections, and prepaid passes

will be available to purchase at the Shire Administration offices after 1 July 2021. For more information please contact the Shire.

The purpose of a Waste Transfer Station is to minimise the amount of waste going to landfill, and maximise opportunitites for recycling. By sorting your load before you go to the Tip, and making sure your recyclables are clean and uncontaminated, you will be doing your bit to help our environment.

Tambellup Primary School

The last two terms have been bursting with extra curricula activities for our students and building relationships with our wider community.




