

### FROM THE MARCH COUNCIL MEETING

The March Ordinary Meeting of Council provided an opportunity for the rolling cycle of policy reviews to commence. This month, the Council considered a wide range of policies including Records Management, Equal Opportunity, Tourism and Area Promotion, Appointment of Bush Fire Control Officers, Roadside Burning and Cemetery Exhumation. A new policy relating to Removal Expenses for Senior Staff was considered and adopted.

Council endorsed proposed amendment local laws and a new proposed Parking Local Law for advertising.

Council endorsed the Pandemic Response and Action Plan, which forms part of the Shire's business continuity planning.

### **WORKS**

COVID-19 is starting to impact our Works program, with a number of staff members needing to isolate due to being close contacts. This is making scheduling challenging, however we are fortunate to have a multi-talented team who can step up and fill in as required to keep jobs ticking over. Contractors are also advising of delays due to staff shortages.

Works on Toolbrunup Rd have come to a temporary halt, as we wait for the contractors to move to site for stabilising. In the meantime, the construction crew has moved to Tieline Road where a 2km section is undergoing repair. These works take in the intersection at Norrish Rd, where the curve is being widened and sealed. If you are travelling in the vicinity of these works we remind you to drive to the conditions and observe all warning signage in the area.

The crew has also been on Broomehill-Kojonup Rd, undertaking surface correction and pavement repair on various patches.

The Broomehill Primary School carpark has been completed, with only permanent line marking and minor signage to be finalised. The new footpath on Journal St between the Post Office and the Caravan Park has been completed.

### SHIRE OF BROOMEHILL-TAMBELLUP TOWN PLANNING SCHEME NO. 2 - PROPOSED AMENDMENT NO. 6

The Shire has commenced the process to amend the Town Planning Scheme, to change the zoning of the former Tambellup Bowling Club and the adjacent lots at the corner of Taylor St and Crowden St. The purpose of the rezoning is to broaden the potential use of the land into the future.

In consultation with community members and community organisations it has been identified that the lack of short stay accommodation facilities in Tambellup is detrimental to the attraction of visitors and short term workers to our community. The former Bowling Club has been identified as a potential site for the development of a caravan park with camping grounds and short stay chalets, however the current zoning of the land does not allow for it to be used for this purpose.

The consultation period for this proposed amendment has commenced, with written submissions to be forwarded to the Shire by 20 May.

### **EASTER ARRANGEMENTS**

The Shire offices will be closed on Good Friday 15 April 2022 and Easter Monday 18 April 2022. We wish all residents and visitors to the Shire a happy Easter break. If you are travelling over Easter, please drive to the conditions, take regular breaks, minimise distractions and aim to arrive at your destination!

### **ANZAC DAY**

The Shire offices will be closed on Monday 25 April for ANZAC Day. With services being held in Broomehill and Tambellup again this year, we take the opportunity to advise residents that Norrish St will be closed to all traffic from 9.30am – 11.30am to allow the service to take place at the War Memorial. Our thanks to the Tambellup Lions Club, Tambellup CWA and Broomehill Heritage Group for organising the community services.

### **BROOMEHILL ORAL HISTORY PROJECT**

The Shire has been working closely with the Broomehill Heritage Group to bring to a close our longest running project, the Broomehill Oral History Project. The project, which was commenced in 2000 by the former Shire of Broomehill

with funding from Lotterywest, saw interviews recorded with around 50 long term and former residents of Broomehill, reflecting on their memories of life in Broomehill over many years. The interviews were then transcribed into written form.

We are pleased to advise all materials have now been transferred to the JS Battye Library of West Australian History, for accessioning into their collection. We are hopeful the audio recordings will be migrated over to new technology, to enable these important records to be accessed by the community more broadly.

Many thanks to the Broomehill Heritage Group, and in particular Shona Webster, for her perseverance with this project.

We have noted increase of unreported damages and anti-social behaviour in our community of late.

It is important for everyone to play their part in keeping our community safe and reporting these incidents as they occur. Reporting criminal damage or stolen items is vital for your local police in gathering intelligence, statistics, running operation and may even assist in their investigations to other potentially related incidents.

If you wish to report these incidents from the comfort of your home, you can lodge a report online.

# How do I lodge a report online?

To lodge a report online please visit:

When making a report online, include a detailed description of the theft or criminal damage.

Only add one item at first and you will then be emailed further instructions on how to add more.

It is important to note that you cannot lodge an online report if the theft or criminal damage relates to:

- vehicle registration plates, motor vehicles, trailers or caravans
- credit or debit cards
- suspects, witnesses or CCTV footage

In all of the above cases, you must call police on 131 444 where a task will be created and the nearest police vehicle will be dispatched. If we are unavailable another vehicle will be dispatched for attendance and I will be informed of the actions that are completed.



Pursuant to Section 75 of the Planning and Development Act 2005, notice is hereby given that the Shire has initiated Amendment No 6 for the purpose of commencing public advertising.

The Amendment proposes to:

- 1. Amend 'Schedule 2 Special Use Zones' by deleting the particulars of the land described as 'Lots 3 to 6 inclusive Crowden Street: Lot 19 Taylor Street; and right-off-way off Taylor Street adjacent to Lots 5, 6 and 19; Tambellup' and deleting the Special Use described as 'Private club including private recreation' as applicable to a right of way, Lot 5 (No 13) Crowden Street, Lot 6 (No 11) Crowden Street and Lot 19 (No 19) Taylor Street, Tambellup.
- Re-zone Lot 5 (No 13) Crowden Street, Lot 6 (No 11) Crowden Street, Lot 19 (No 19) Taylor Street, Tambellup and the adjacent right-of-way from 'Special Use' zone to 'Town Centre' zone as depicted on the Scheme Amendment Map.
- Delete the existing definition for 'camping area' and 'caravan park' from 'Schedule 1-Interpetations' and inserting new definitions for 'camping ground' and 'caravan park' in alphabetical order in 'Schedule 1-Interpetations' as follows:
