

#### SHOWCASE IN PIXELS – WINNERS!

The Showcase in Pixels competition is conducted annually by the Western Australian Local Government Association, coinciding with the WALGA conference in Perth. All local governments are eligible to invite their community to create a themed artwork to be displayed on the 45-metre-high digital tower at the heart of Yagan Square in Perth City during the conference. The winners of the competition for 2022 were announced at the WALGA Conference on Tuesday 4 October.

#### FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING

• The Council received the minutes of the 2020/2021 Annual Electors meeting held on the 15th September 2022, and the Local Emergency Management Committee meeting held on the 20th September 2022.

- The annual Freedom of Information Statement was reviewed by the Council prior to publishing on the Shire's website.
- A rates concession was granted to the Broomehill Village Cooperative (Inc.) for the 2022/2023 financial year.
- A subdivision application seeking boundary realignments for lots off Broomehill-Gnowangerup Rd was supported.
- An application for planning consent for the development of an outbuilding (agricultural storage shed) at Lot 4484 Batchelor Rd was approved with conditions.
- The Council determined that the quote provided by WesTrac for the purchase of a new front end wheeled loader and trade of the existing loader be accepted.

#### WORKS

Construction works have commenced on the widening of Chillicup Rd, with culvert widening and clearing works in progress. General maintenance has been undertaken on roads, including replacement of road signs where required, pothole patching, removal of fallen branches, and spraying of road verges for weed control. Spring presents ideal conditions for maintenance to our ovals, and to date, they have been mowed, fertilised, sprayed for broadleaf weeds, clover and black beetle and reticulation tested and repaired where required. Vertimowing, coring and top dressing is yet to be completed. Fogging of the town sites for mosquitos has continued during October.

At the Broomehill Recreation Complex, work has commenced to upgrade the drainage to alleviate water logging at the northern end of the oval. The garden areas around the new ramps and steps have been planted out, and lawn has been installed on the terraces.

Two x 110 kilolitre water tanks have been installed at the Tambellup Works Depot, with one x 250 kilolitre water tank still to be installed at the Broomehill Works Depot. A standpipe controller system will be installed on one tank located at the Tambellup Depot.

#### STRATEGIC COMMUNITY PLAN REVIEW

We previously advised that the draft Strategic Community Plan would be available following the October 2022 Council meeting. The draft Strategic Community Plan will now be considered by the Council at the November 2022 Ordinary meeting, and will then be available for public information.

## ARE YOU INTERESTED IN OUR HERITAGE PLACES?

The Shire is undertaking a review of its Municipal Inventories, which were compiled by the former Shires of Broomehill and Tambellup in the late 1990s. The review process will result in the compilation of a Local Heritage List, and the development of a Local Heritage

Strategy that will inform the Council's planning decisions relating to heritage places in the Shire.

A heritage consultant has been engaged by the Shire to re-assess places already listed on the separate inventories for Broomehill and Tambellup, and we invite members of the community to consider whether there are additional places in the Shire that could be assessed for inclusion. These places will be assessed prior to making any recommendations to the Council.

### IT'S NEARLY BUSHFIRE SEASON AGAIN.....

All residents are advised the **PROHIBITED** burning period commences on the **1st of NOVEMBER 2022**. No burning is permitted from this date until the **14th of FEBRUARY 2023**.

Residents are reminded of their obligation to minimise the risk of fire on their property. In particular, on townsite and urban land the height of any grass on the lot must be no higher than 150mm. Property inspections will be undertaken early in November, and owners of non-compliant properties will be requested to undertake works to reduce the hazard. #### **Construction Activities Update**

Relevant Development Approvals for the Flat Rocks Wind Farm Stage 1 have been obtained from the Kojonup and Broomehill-Tambellup Shire Councils. The planning approval sets out conditions for the project, including management plans. These plans have been presented to Council for approval with some of these plans still undergoing review. Following green light from both Shires the following activities have commenced:

- Establishment of the temporary site facilities including the site offices, crib room, toilets and skip bins.
- Construction of approved internal roads; and
- Grading of Warrannup Road between The Batch Plant Access and the Quarry Area.

In order to control dust levels while grading works are undertaken Westforce, Civil contractors for the Project, will operate a water kart in the area.


Tambellup Primary School represented the Shire of Broomehill Tambellup by creating an art piece which reflected the way our students see our community.
