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Introduction

The study

In March-April, the Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup administered a MARKYT® Community Scorecard to evaluate community priorities and measure Council's performance against key indicators in the Strategic Community Plan.


Scorecard invitations were sent to all households and PO Boxes using Australia Post unaddressed mail. The Shire offered supporting promotions through its communication channels.

In total, **118 residents** submitted a response, representing approximately 33% of households*.

The sample included 16 council-affiliated respondents. As analysis shows their views vary significantly to non-affiliated residents, the main body of this report presents responses from 102 non-council affiliated residents only.

The final dataset was weighted by age and gender to match the ABS Census population profile. Data has been analysed using SPSS. Where sub-totals add to ±1% of the parts, this is due to rounding errors to zero decimal places.


Overall Performance | industry comparisons


How to read the MARKYT � Benchmark Matrix TM

The MARKYT® Benchmark Matrix TM (shown in detail overleaf) illustrates how the community rates performance on individual measures, compared to how other councils are being rated by their communities.

There are two dimensions. The vertical axis maps community perceptions of performance for individual measures relative to the average score for all measures. The horizontal axis maps performance relative to the MARKYT® Industry Standards.

This line represents Council's average performance for all individual measure.
As it represents the average, around half of the service areas will be placed above the line, and around half will be positioned below the line.


MARKYT Community Priorities Window TM


Sport and recreation facilities are considered to be a key strength in the Shire.

Building and maintaining local roads

Challenges | identified by the community

- Condition of rural roads.
- · Heavy vehicles damaging surfaces.
- Grading not carried out regularly enough.
- Dangerous verges and shoulders.

Actions | suggested by the community

- 1. Carry out grading more often.
- 2. Improve the quality of grading and road maintenance.
- 3. Seal frequently used gravel roads.
- 4. Repair truck damage.
- 5. Make sure verges and shoulders are clear and safe.

Community Voices

"Roads firstly."

"Roads - gravel, shoulders, signage."

"Repairing tarmac road in centre of town."

"More roads to be suitable for road trains."

"Roads - they are good but could be better."

"Finish the job that you have started. Too many road, footpath, kerbing jobs are left half completed."

"Clearing of trees along side of roads. Maintaining gravel roads more."

"We get our gravel road graded but never have the corrugations cut off."

"Upgrade local gravel roads, more frequent grading; sealing where possible."

"We would like to see an improvement in the state and upgrade of gravel roads within the Shire as in our job we use a lot of gravel roads and have driven on a lot of poor road conditions. We would like to see roads graded more regularly, especially those on the further Shire boundary areas."

"All Shires need to come together to avert the looming transport infrastructure crisis. Due to closure of the vast majority of country rail lines and the explosion of trucks our roads are crumbling."

"Enticing people to move to town, keep all businesses open and operating 100% and all businesses encouraged to paint, renovate, clean and sweep etc. their shop fronts...I know the Shire is not responsible for any of the above, but they play a huge part of our community. Therefore, their encouragement and input can improve the "face" of a business. Our town looks welcoming and Shire is doing a great job!"

"Attracting more people to live in the shire."

"Encourage further development in our towns we need to build the size of our communities to survive. Short term accommodation capable of encouraging companies and tourists to stop in our town."

"Bringing families back to the town although jobs are minimal.

Population growth might keep the town viable."

"Encouraging economic development. Security. Assisting with providing opportunities for unemployment within the area (assisting private businesses)."

"It would be great to have an industry other than farming here. We don't have many employment opportunities - ripple effect, such as houses going to rack and ruin as no-one will pay for improvements because they'll never sell their house for a profit."

The **Performance Index Score** is a score out of 100 using the following formula:

In effect, the Performance Index Score converts the average rating into a zero-based score out of 100.







Likelihood of recommending the Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup as a place to live


























Preferred channels for having a say

Views vary across the community. For example, younger adults are more open to be engaged through social media.


How would you prefer to have your say on local issues or projects?










