FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING



TAMBELLUP CARAVAN PARK UPDATE - CABINS PURCHASED!

It's happening!! We're delighted to announce that the first three cabins have been ordered for installation at the Caravan Park. These are a one bedroom, self-contained modular design and will be constructed offsite, before being transported to Tambellup and installed by the end of 2024. (The image is indicative only)

The passes are valid until August 2025. Additional passes are available to purchase for \$25 from either of the Shire Offices.

WHAT HAVE WE BEEN UP TO DURING JULY?



We farewelled Darryl Pickett, who commenced his retirement after 18 years with the Shire. Well done Darryl and enjoy this next chapter!

We were pleased to support a school project initiated by Broomehill's Tom Dennis, to enhance the surrounds at the Broomehill Skate Park. Tom worked alongside Parks and Gardens Staff to plant trees and native shrubs and place rocks. Well done Tom on your initiative. More work is planned by Tom for this area later in the year too watch this space!



We've planted new street trees along Crawford St, Saggers St, Henry St and various other locations. The

trees are ornamental pears and will inject some colour into the streetscape during spring and autumn. These will be maintained for the first couple of summers and will then be well established to survive on their own.





We've re-commenced the Crowden St upgrade project, starting with the replacement of kerbing and paving on the southern side. Thanks to PEP Building Improvements for their efforts here!

Solar lights have been installed at the Tambellup Community Pavilion to light the pathway to the western carpark, making this a far less treacherous trip at night.



New Medical Service for Gnowangerup and surrounds

Livingston Medical have hit the ground running this week in Gnowangerup with Dr Livingston offering face to face appointments for the next 5 weeks until the new resident Doctor commences.

In the absence of a medical service, Dr Menon and Dr Livingston have also been offering a telehealth service prior to Livingston Medical Gnowangerup commencing on 22nd July in order to help with ongoing clinical care.

The community have been incredibly welcoming and we would love to thank everybody involved in the process. The Shire, the Council, the community but most of all Kate Humphries who has been instrumental in reassuring the community and patients that a new Doctor is coming, worked tirelessly to get all the old equipment and mountains of clutter cleared and cleaned and ready for the new tenants and made us feel so welcome with all of her heartfelt lovely energy.

We are so privileged that Kate has chosen to stay on at the practice and remain in the community doing what she is truly passionate about. Nursing her patients with love and care.

The practice phone number is staying the same but we will now have online bookings.

The Practice will open 5 days per week and we will have a regular Doctor living in town plus multiple other Doctors offering visiting support and assistance.

Dr Brian West will be the local Gnowangerup Doctor commencing on the 26th August.

Dr West graduated from Sheffield University, UK in 1993.

Brian initially trained in surgery with a special interest in ENT and went on to become a GP in 2001.

Dr West and his family relocated to Australia in 2008, initially working in Perth before relocating to Melbourne. Dr West has advanced skills in skin cancer medicine and has a long history of working in skin cancer clinics. Dr West will also be providing services at the local Gnowangerup hospital and in conjunction with Dr Makar and Dr Livingston will be running Aboriginal Health clinics in multiple towns.

Many of you may have already met Dr Livingston, he is very passionate when it comes to rural healthcare and he offers a number of services and will travel down to the Gnowangerup area on a regular basis to provide various procedures and services.

Many will get to meet Dr Makar over the next few weeks too. Dr Makar is originally from Egypt and has been practicing rural medicine across Queensland and Western Australia for the past 10 years. Dr Makar will be a regular face in Gnowangerup and the surrounding towns.

Watch this space for the announcement of many new services and visiting health professionals. We will endeavour to work together with the community to deliver exceptional health care and will always take feedback and offer solutions where possible.

The practice is a mixed billing practice and children under 16, pension card holders aged over 70 and Aboriginal Torres Strait Islanders all having access to bulk billed services.




