SHIRE OF BROOMEHILL-TAMBELLUP UPDATES

FROM THE SEPTEMBER COUNCIL MEETING

- The reviewed Corporate Business Plan (Plan) was adopted by the Council. The revised document has condensed the 198 initiatives contained in the existing Plan into 47 high-level actions aligned to the key pillars of the Strategic Community Plan Point of Difference, Economy, Lifestyle and Shire Support. Staff will be working towards achieving the outcomes of the Plan over the next four years, with quarterly progress reporting to the Council and community. The Plan is available on the Shire's website at https://www.shirebt.wa.gov.au/council/your-council/shire-plans.aspx under 'Adopted Corporate Plans'.
- The Council voted to endorse the draft Local Planning Policy Wind Farms, for public comment. More information is available at https://www.shirebt.wa.gov.au/publicnotices/.
- The Council also supported the Shire President's letter to the Premier of Western Australia and relevant Ministers, requesting the development of a renewable energy policy framework and the inclusion of our Shire as part of that process.

As always, agendas, minutes and associated documents from all Council meetings are available on the Shire's website www.shirebt.wa.gov.au under 'Council Meetings'. Copies are available for perusal at the Shire Administration Offices and Tambellup CRC. Documents are available in other formats on request, if required by people with disability.

The next Ordinary Council Meeting will be held on <u>Thursday 17 October 2024 commencing at 4.30pm</u>, in the Tambellup Council Chambers. Members of the public are welcome to attend all Council meetings.

INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRESS

- Gravel road maintenance is our current priority following the winter rains. Should you wish to report any
 roads which require attention, please contact please contact the Shire on 9825 3555 or
 mail@shirebt.wa.gov.au.
- Roadside weed spraying is underway, following a period of windy conditions in recent weeks which initially slowed progress.
- With the start of the construction program just around the corner, the gravel requirements have been stockpiled for works on Nymbup Rd (3km of gravel sheeting), Pallinup Rd (construct and seal a 2km section) and Warrenup Rd (reconstruct and seal a 3km section).
- The installation of new kerbing and paving on Crowden St has been completed.

RESTRICTED BURNING PERIOD COMMENCES 1 OCTOBER 2024!

Spring is definitely here, and while everything is green at the moment, it won't be very long before it dries out – and with that, comes the increased risk of fire. TO REPORT A FIRE PLEASE CALL 000!

From Tuesday 1 October 2024 to Thursday 31 October 2024, residents wishing to conduct a burn are required to obtain a permit from their Brigade Fire Control Officer. Please note - permits will not be issued during this period for burning of logs, stumps or timber heaps.

The Prohibited Burning Period commences on 1 November 2024 and is in place until 2 March 2025. No burning is permitted during this period.

All residents have an obligation to prepare their property prior to the fire season, to reduce the risk of fire. For more information please refer to the Shire's website https://www.shirebt.wa.gov.au/shire-services/fire-and-emergency- management/property-owner-information.aspx

Owners and occupiers should note, during the period 31 October 2024 – 15 April 2025:

- Townsite lots of less than 4000 square metres all flammable material should be removed from the property (except for live standing trees).
- Townsite lots exceeding 4000 square metres, and townsite lots zoned Special Rural/Rural Residential firebreaks not less than 2 metres in width should be installed completely surrounding (and not more than 20 metres from) the perimeter of all buildings, haystacks and fuel storage areas on the land. Importantly – the height of all grass on the land is to be less than 150mm in height.
- Townsite inspections will be carried out to ensure compliance with the Fire Break Order.

- With ALL lids removed


