

TED WITHAM'S MEMOIR SKERRICKS HAS JUST BEEN PUBLISHED

Stuart Witham is Ted's nephew and Jim is his brother. Jim features in the memoir. Tambellup identities of the 1950s also get mentions.

Skerricks is reviewed here by Shirley Claughton, proprietor of St Johns Books, Fremantle.

"This "farm kid" accomplished so much that he even seems to surprise himself at times! Ted grew up in Tambellup in the 1950s and that upbringing influenced the rest of his life. Despite astonishing difficulties Ted faced in infancy and as a young man, he went on to become a revered priest and respected educator. In "Skerricks" we also catch glimpses of the fragments of his life that cultivated a warmth and integrity which Ted has displayed in his life, from championing reform as school chaplain, whereby he instigated significant changes in school culture.

A distinguishing feature of this book is that the author has "used the real names of real people throughout this memoir". This surely gives honour and recognition where it is due and is also a charming quality. Nevertheless, he wittingly adds that he has "changed just a few names to protect either that person or myself... In one or two rare cases, my memory of a name has failed me, and I have invented the name."

The stories recounted throughout make it hard to put the book down – and just like Ted's life itself, is absolutely unique."

Before the October Council meeting, a Citizenship Ceremony took place, during which Shire President Cr White conferred citizenship to new Tambellup resident Alex Paxton. It's always a pleasure to be part of these ceremonies, and we extend our congratulations to Alex on this special occasion.



The Council considered an application for planning approval, for the development of workers accommodation on Lot 2386 (No. 627) Brown Road. Public comment on the proposal is invited and more information can be found at www.shirebt.wa.gov.au under 'Public Notices'. The closing date for submissions is Wednesday 6 November 2024.

The Council adopted fees and charges relating to the new Community Bus. The bus, which has been generously donated by the Tambellup Community Cropping Group, seats 10 people including the driver (or 8 plus one wheelchair) and will be available for hire once the bull bar has been fitted and decals applied. More information on how to hire the bus will be made available via our website and on our Facebook page in the coming weeks.

The Corporate Business Plan quarterly report for July-September 2024 was received. At the end of the first quarter for 2024/2025 several actions have been completed or are ongoing. The Corporate Business Plan was reviewed at the September 2024 Council meeting and included the consolidation of the previous 199 actions into 46 high level initiatives to be delivered over the next four-year period. The Plan is available at www.shirebt.wa.gov.au under 'Shire Plans'.

As always, agendas, minutes and associated documents from all Council meetings are available on the Shire's website www.shirebt.wa.gov.au under 'Council Meetings'. Copies are available for perusal at the Shire Administration Offices and Tambellup CRC. Documents are available in other formats on request, if required by people with disability.

The next Ordinary Council Meeting will be held on Thursday 21 November 2024 commencing at 4.30pm, in the Tambellup Council Chambers. Members of the public are welcome to attend all Council meetings.

INFRASTRUCTURE UPDATE

The construction program is underway, with gravel sheeting and culvert replacement in progress on Nymbup Rd. At the October Council meeting the Council awarded the tender for bitumen supply for the major construction projects - Pallinup Road (construct and seal a 2km section) and Warrenup Road (construct and seal a 7km section north from Tambellup West Rd). Gravel has been stockpiled for these projects and work will commence on Warrenup Rd during December, dependent on harvest activity.

Bitumen contractors were in town recently, completing asphalt overlays on Taylor St and North Terrace, and repairing a failed section on Gnowangerup-Tambellup Rd. The repair of bitumen failures on Broomehill-Kojonup Rd and Tambellup West Rd will commence late November.

Grading of roads has been completed from the southeast around to the northwest of the Shire, and work is now progressing along the northeast area.

As residents may be aware, the Shire has contracted BGL Solutions to manage the ongoing maintenance of the Broomehill and Tambellup sports grounds. Both ovals are now in amazing condition and were ready for the start of the cricket season. We wish all our cricketers a successful season!

The gardens around the tennis courts in Tambellup were refreshed prior to the Club's Opening Day on 12 October, and line marking of the bottom two courts was completed.

Handrails were installed at the Tambellup Community Pavilion main steps leading to the oval. This was an initiative that came from the community during consultation for the Disability Access and Inclusion Plan, and we're really pleased to see them in place.



BUSHFIRE SEASON IS HERE!

November has arrived, the vegetation is drying off, and on 1 November 2024, the Prohibited Burning period commences.

- From 1 November 2024 until 2 March 2025 no fires are to be lit.
- To report a fire – call 000. This is the most efficient way of getting assistance.
- Have you prepared your family and your home for the fire season? Go to <https://www.dfes.wa.gov.au/hazard-information/bushfire/prepare> for more information.
- Do you have a Bushfire Plan? Scan the QR code to go to the My Bushfire Plan website – just 15 minutes is all it takes.



Residents are reminded of their obligation to minimise the risk of fire on their property. In particular, on townsite and urban land, the height of any grass on the lot must be no higher than 150mm. Property inspections will be undertaken early in November, and owners of non-compliant properties will be requested to undertake works to reduce the hazard.
