The past few weeks have seen challenging weather conditions across the region, with some significant fires occurring, not least being the fire that threatened the Broomehill townsite on 3 December 2025. We extend a heartfelt thank you to all those from our Shire and neighbouring areas who assisted in controlling and extinguishing the fire on the day, and then followed up over the ensuing days to make sure there were no flare ups. The prompt response by all who attended, and a handy wind change, significantly reduced the threat to the town. Congratulations to Chief Bushfire Control Officer Michael Altus on his efficient management of the incident.



On 13 December, a visit from the Department of Fire and Emergency Services Community Preparedness Officer, Mel Haymont, provided an opportunity for residents to share their experiences during the fire, and learn more about how they could be better prepared for next time.

A key discussion at the session centred on the timeliness of the evacuation message that was issued that day. It's important to note there are many moving parts and approvals required for the Department of Fire and Emergency Services to issue an evacuation notice, and these all take time, therefore the decision to order an evacuation is not taken lightly. Added to this is the variability in internet connectivity in our area which may delay the delivery of messaging. Unfortunately, much of this is out of the Shire's control. Please don't wait for a knock at the door, a text, or an update on your social media to alert you to changing conditions – be aware of your environment, realistic about your capabilities, and enact your plan early (go to mybushfireplan.wa.gov.au to prepare your plan).

While we'd rather not experience incidents of this nature, the fire provided the opportunity to test some of the Shire's emergency management procedures, including communications, road closures and evacuation. In consultation with key brigade members, the Local Emergency Management Committee will review the incident at its next meeting in February.

FROM THE DECEMBER COUNCIL MEETING

With a view to enhancing water harvesting and storage needed to maintain the Broomehill Recreation Complex facilities, the Council endorsed the Broomehill Recreational Complex Water Security Plan. Elements of the plan include increasing the size of the holding pond at the front of the Complex dam; compaction and sealing of the Complex dam catchment; reconnection of infrastructure at the Town dam to allow for transfer of water to and from the Complex dam; and upgrade of the pump and solar system at the dam opposite the CBH site on Nardlah Rd. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by the end of June 2025. Ongoing consultation and community feedback will occur to ensure implementation of the Plan meets the needs of the Complex.

With the finalisation of the annual audit, the Council adopted the Annual Report for 2023-2024. The Annual Report which details our financial reports and achievements for the last financial year is available on the Shire's website www.shirebt.wa.gov.au – go to the side menu on the home page, then Document Centre/ Annual Reports. Copies are also available at the Shire administration offices.

The Council also set the date for the Annual General Meeting of Electors. This meeting will be held on Thursday 20 February 2025, commencing at 6.00pm at the Tambellup Council Chambers. All members of the public are welcome to attend.

BROOMEHILL HALL ACOUSTICS

Let the bubble wrap be gone! During December, the Shire installed new acoustic panels at the Broomehill Hall, which are suspended from the roof. The rationale is that soundwaves are absorbed by the panels, instead of bouncing off hard surfaces like walls, the floor and the ceiling, therefore reducing the level of sound reflected into the room.



BUSHFIRE SEASON IS HERE!

- To report a fire – call 000. This is the most efficient way of getting assistance.
- From 1 November 2024 until 2 March 2025 the Prohibited Burning Period is in effect - no fires are to be lit during this period.
- Permits to burn are required during the Restricted Burning Period 3 March – 15 April 2025.
- Easter – 18-21 April 2025 – Burning is prohibited.
- What will you do in the event of a bushfire? Scan the QR code to go to the My Bushfire Plan website and make your plan – just 15 minutes is all it takes.
