

FROM THE MARCH COUNCIL MEETING Broomehill Recreational Complex-Water Security Plan Stage 2

The Council has endorsed Stage 2 of the Water Security Plan for the Broomehill Recreational Complex.

The aim of this plan is to enhance water security for the Broomehill Recreational Complex, to help provide the Complex with enough water throughout each year to maintain the Oval and gardens.

Stage 1 of this plan was endorsed at the December 2024 Council meeting, consisting of 4 actions, 2 of which were completed shortly in the new year, with alternative agreements made during consultations with the Broomehill Recreational Complex Committee for the remaining two actions.

Stage 2 is comprised of 6 actions, which includes the purchase and installation of a new generator and pump, improvements to connections for the existing solar pump, clearing around the catchment area at the Complex Dam and ongoing advocacy for power to be connected to the Catchment Dam.

Historic Jarrah Floorboards & Skirting — Up for Auction!






