The Works Manager advised the Plaques would be removed on 19 Feb 24 which was the case.

Then the Courier lost the package for Three Months which added to the time frame.

Yes I am happy that this exercise is now complete, but years behind because of the Shire's Non Action.

Tambellup Caravan Park - Progress Update

Things are taking shape at the Tambellup Caravan Park, and we're excited to share the latest with you! Stage 1 site works are almost complete, with just the right weather needed for contractors to seal and kerb the internal roadways.

In great news, we welcomed the arrival of the first three cabins in late June! Built in Perth and transported to site, the cabins have been carefully positioned on their new foundations, ready for the next phase of works, including utility connections.

There's still a bit more to do before the cabins are open for guests. Coming up next: installation of a prefabricated laundry, paving of car bays, steps to each cabin, fencing, and landscaping around the area to create an inviting, comfortable setting.

We've hit a small snag with the power connection, but rest assured we're working closely with Western Power to get things moving as quickly as possible. Thanks for your patience, this is an exciting step forward for our town, and we can't wait to see the park come to life!



What's Been Happening Around Town

With this year's major roadworks program now wrapped up, our works crews have shifted their focus to some smaller, but equally important projects across the Shire.

At both the Broomehill and Tambellup cemeteries, new water tanks and taps have been installed, making it easier for visitors to care for grave sites and floral arrangements. The tanks, cleverly positioned behind the Niche Walls, are topped up by rainwater collected from the gazebos—and thanks to recent showers, they're already filling up.

Over at the Tambellup cemetery, the old niche wall has been removed and the area cleared and mulched, ready for new plantings. It's already making a noticeable difference to the overall look and feel of the site.

The upgrade of the Gordon River picnic area and walking trail continues to progress well. We've sealed and kerbed the car park for better access and repaired a washout on the trail to improve safety for walkers enjoying the area.





Our ovals are looking great but we're keeping a close eye Customer Service Survey on water supplies that keep our parks and sporting grounds green. The recent rain has given us a welcome boost, and we're hopeful for a good wet season ahead to top up our dams.

Thanks to everyone in the community for your continued support, it's your Shire, and we're proud to keep it looking great.

McGuire Road - Drive Safe

We've recently heard from residents about concerns 9825 3555. about driver behaviour on McGuire Road. In response, the Shire will be requesting a formal review of the current speed limit by Main Roads WA.

In the meantime, new signage has been installed to remind motorists that McGuire Road is a no- through road and to encourage safe and sensible driving. As always, we ask everyone to drive to the conditions and show consideration for nearby landowners and fellow road users.

Musica Viva






The Shire has received an application for a 60 metre high lattice tower and associated infrastructure proposed on the abovementioned lot.

Rules for all WA drivers

WA drivers can only touch a mobile phone to make, receive and terminate calls if the phone is secured in a cradle mounted to the vehicle.

If the phone is not secured in a cradle, you can only receive or terminate calls without touching the phone. E.g. using: voice commands; a Bluetooth hands-free car kit; an earpiece; or a headset.

It is illegal for all drivers to create, send or look at a text message, video message, email, dictate a text to Siri or similar – even if the phone is mounted in a cradle or can be operating without touching it.




