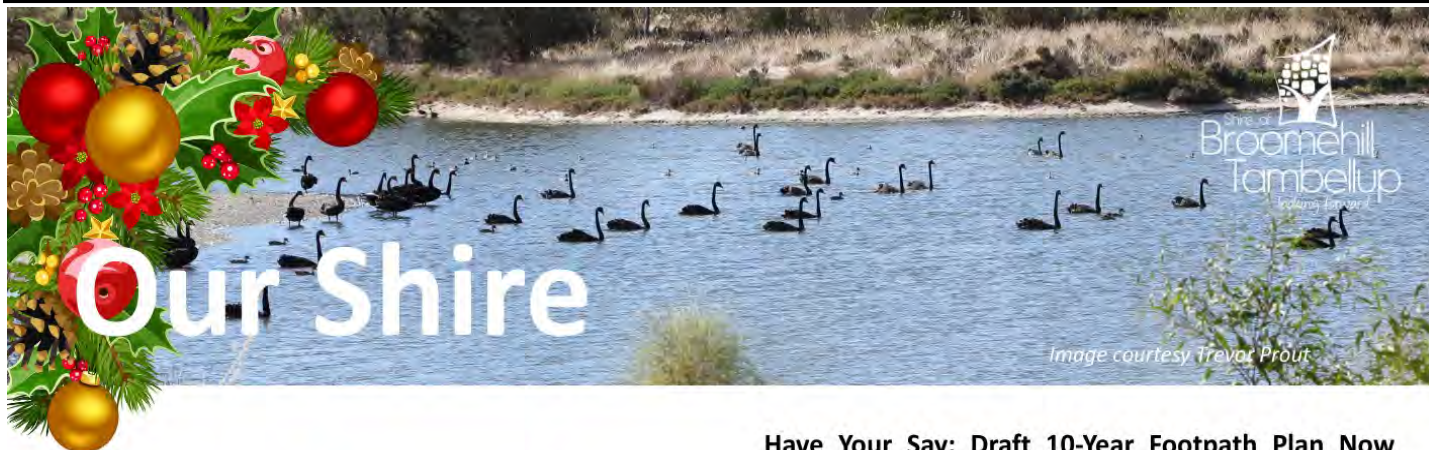

The Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup is planning the future of footpaths and we want your input! The Draft 10-Year Footpath Plan 2026–2036 outlines a long-term program to improve safety, accessibility, and connectivity across our towns.

The plan focuses on linking key community facilities, schools, main streets, and recreation spaces, drawing on community feedback and strategic guidance from:

- WA Cycling Strategy 2050
- Great Southern Regional Trails Masterplan
- Local Bike Plans for Broomehill and Tambellup
- Local data on path conditions and pedestrian use

What's in the Plan?

- Upgrades to existing paths in poor condition
- New pathway links to fill missing connections
- Extensions for walking, prams, wheelchairs, and riding
- Kerb ramps to improve accessibility

Tambellup Caravan Park Update

While it might seem quiet at the Caravan Park, there's plenty happening behind the scenes as we work towards having the new cabins ready by February 2026.

A final inspection of the site works took place in mid-November, and several items were flagged for the contractor to address before the Shire can officially take handover. Once that's complete, we'll move on to paving, fencing, landscaping, signage, and the all-important cabin fit-out.

Construction of the laundry building has continued throughout November. This facility will serve cabin guests and support our cleaning team. Planning for Stage 2, which includes caravan bays and a full amenities block with laundry, is still underway.

The Shire extends its heartfelt thanks to the Tambellup Community Cropping Group for their incredible support and generosity. On 13 November 2025, the Tambellup Community Cropping Group voted to approve an increased donation of \$426,000 + GST for the purchase of a one-bedroom cabin and a four-room donga for the Tambellup Caravan Park. This generous contribution will significantly enhance accommodation options for visitors and support the long-term success of the park. Their contribution is a major boost for the Caravan Park project and demonstrates the strength of community collaboration in making the Shire a welcoming destination for visitors.

Progress has also been made on the online booking system. The same platform used successfully at Broomehill Caravan Park will soon include Tambellup. The backend setup is complete, and once live, bookings will be available via the Shire's website.

Grants and Funding Success for Broomehill-Tambellup

The Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup is pleased to share some exciting news about recent funding successes that will deliver major improvements across our communities.

Water Harvesting and Reuse Initiatives

We've secured \$234,000 from the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation to implement additional water harvesting and reuse projects in Broomehill and Tambellup.

Broomehill:

- Extending the catchment seal at the Broomehill Complex Dam
- Upgrading the pump and fencing at the Town Dam
- Installing a new pump on Bignell's Dam

Tambellup:

- Replacing all irrigation cabling to improve system performance
- Installing an automated water management system to monitor dam and tank levels remotely

These upgrades build on the Shire's ongoing commitment to maintaining our recreation and public open spaces sustainably.

Safer Roads Grant

We've received \$1.5 million through the Safer Roads Program for improvements to Broomehill-Kojonup Road over two years (2025–26 and 2026–27). Works will include:

- Widening the seal by approximately 1 metre
- Widening culverts where required
- Vegetation pruning
- Renewing centre and edge line marking
- Adding audible edge and centre line marking
- Repairing potholes with asphalt

This grant is 100% funded by the State Government.

Regional Road Group (RRG) Funding

Our 2026–27 RRG submissions were all supported for endorsement at the recent meeting in Gnowangerup:

- \$480,000 for Warrenup Road
- \$430,000 for Tieline Road
- \$420,000 for Tambellup West Road

We're also exploring a potential \$3 million grant for the upgrade and reconstruction of the southern section of Warrenup Road under another Safer Roads initiative. Stay tuned for updates.

Black Spot Projects

Applications for Black Spot Funding will open after Christmas. We already have a few projects identified through our AI data analysis, but we welcome suggestions from Councillors and ratepayers.

Smarter Planning

This year's tenders and plans have been more accurate and targeted thanks to the AI Data Pickup and support, helping us prioritise projects effectively.

We're proud of these achievements and look forward to delivering these improvements for our community. Thank you for your ongoing support.

New Limestone Steps for Broomehill Sporting Complex

The Broomehill Sporting Complex has received a fantastic upgrade thanks to a great collaboration between the Broomehill Cricket Club and the Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup. New limestone steps have been installed at the complex, improving access and safety for players, spectators, and visitors.

This project is a wonderful example of community and local government working together to enhance our sporting facilities. The steps not only provide a practical improvement but also add to the overall look and functionality of the complex.

A big thank you to the Broomehill Cricket Club for their initiative. These improvements ensure our sporting spaces remain welcoming and accessible for everyone.

Protect Yourself from Mosquito-Borne Diseases in WA

Mosquitoes aren't just annoying, they can spread serious illnesses in Western Australia, including:

- ✓ Ross River virus
- ✓ Barmah Forest virus
- ✓ Kunjin virus
- ✓ Murray Valley encephalitis
- ✓ Japanese encephalitis (JEV)

The best protection? Avoid mosquito bites!

Cover Up – Wear long, loose-fitting, light-coloured clothing.

Repel – Use insect repellent containing DEET, picaridin, or Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus (OLE/PMD).

Clean Up – Remove or cover water-holding containers and keep grass short to reduce breeding sites.



What We're Doing Locally

For the past 18 months, the Shire has been running a proactive mosquito control program that targets breeding areas before mozzies hatch, rather than fogging after the fact.

Our team:

- Monitors larvae numbers
- Baits wetlands, drains, and other likely breeding spots during warmer months
- Responds quickly to any hotspots that emerge

This approach, based on advice from environmental health specialists, has proven effective in other Shires and is working well here too. We'll continue the program throughout the season to help keep mosquito numbers down and reduce disease risk.

Fire Safety Update: Harvest Bans, Vehicle Movement Bans & Total Fire Bans

As fire season approaches, it's important to understand the rules that help keep our community safe.

Harvest and Vehicle Movement Bans

On days of high fire danger, the Shire may impose a Harvest and/or Vehicle Movement Ban.

When these bans are in place:

- No harvesting activity is allowed.
- No operation of engines powered by internal combustion on land with vegetation.

The Shire is divided into two zones for bans and mopping-up operations:

- Eastern Zone
- Western Zone

The boundary is the Great Southern Highway, and any ban on a zone includes both townsites.



Total Fire Bans (TFB)

Declared by the Department of Fire & Emergency Services (DFES), a TFB applies when fire risk is extreme or firefighting resources are stretched.

- TFBs prohibit any activity likely to cause a fire (except agricultural activities).
- They can be declared outside the fire season due to weather conditions.

Fire Break Notice 2025–2026

Property owners must comply with the requirements in the Fire Break Notice.

- Annual inspections will be conducted under the Bush Fires Act 1954.
- Officers and contractors are legally permitted to enter properties for compliance checks.
