The next meeting of Council will be held on <u>Thursday 15 August 2019 commencing at 4.30pm</u> in the Tambellup Council Chambers. Members of the public are welcome to attend all Council meetings.

FROM THE JULY COUNCIL MEETING

Council endorsed the Corporate Business Plan Quarterly Progress report for the period April-June 2019. The report provides information showing the progress the Shire has made towards achieving the strategies contained within the Strategic Community Plan. Following Council's endorsement, this report will be compiled at the end of each quarter, and published on the Shire's website for the community's information. For the full report please check the Shire's website — www.shirebt.wa.gov.au under 'News and Events'. A snapshot of progress is shown below:



Council approved an application for planning consent for Great Southern Financial Services Ltd for signage at 36 Norrish St Tambellup.

The CEO's annual performance review was considered and accepted. The review process, which was undertaken by an independent consultant, recommended that a new five year contract be offered to the CEO. We are pleased to advise Keith has indicated he is happy to stay with us a bit longer – congratulations Keith!

Councillors participated in a budget workshop late in July. The workshop provided an opportunity for all Councillors to gain an understanding of the content of the document and how funding is allocated to the various programs and activities, and discussion about priorities for the coming year. It is intended to adopt the budget at a Special Council Meeting to be held on Tuesday 6 August 2019.

WORKS

With the annual construction program completed in July, thoughts are now turning to the new year and the projects that need to be delivered. A number of funded road construction projects have been confirmed and more detail will be provided in the September Topics following budget adoption. In the meantime, gravel sheeting is underway on Pallinup Rd.

Maintenance grading was completed on the following roads during July: Flat Rocks Rd, West Peringillup Rd, Norrish Rd, Etna Rd, Moulyerup Rd, Batchelor Nth Rd, Martinup Rd, Stirling Access Rd, Sprigg-Simpson Rd, Nazzari Rd, Dartnall Rd.

The Tambellup Hockey Club hosted the Great Southern Carnival during July, and the maintenance and parks and gardens crews were busy completing a myriad of tasks to bring the facilities at the Sportsground to their best, and also assist with arrangements for accommodation of visitors to the town.

Residents from east and west of the townsites may have also have noticed we are officially 'on the map' – with green roadside distance markers showing 'BH' and "TA' installed at 10km intervals on Tieline Rd, Broomehill-Kojonup Rd, Tambellup West Rd and Gnowangerup-Tambellup Rd. New shire boundary markers have also been installed on all roads providing an entry point to the Shire.

GREAT SOUTHERN HOUSING INTIATIVE

The housing project is gaining momentum across the seven Shires, with most at the point of tendering the various components. At a Special Council Meeting held late in July, Council awarded the tender for the construction of key

worker accommodation to RM Smith & Sons from Gnowangerup (four homes in Tambel-lup) and Broomehill's own Countryside Homes (two homes in Broomehill). Council was extremely pleased to be able to support two local businesses who each submitted a very competitive tender with innovative designs. These businesses indicate they will utilise local and regional trades and suppliers.

With the construction timeframes being extremely tight, work has been completed already to remove a number of trees from the building lots in Tambellup, and contractors will be making headway in coming weeks. Alongside the construction of the six homes, the tender has been advertised for the construction of four independent living units in Broomehill. This closes on Thursday 1 August 2019, and following assessment, Council will award the tender at the Special Council Meeting on 6 August. The units have been designed by H&H Architects, and are based on the floorplan of the Sandalwood Villas in Tambellup. The units will be located on the corner of Javelin St and Chillicup Rd, on the south east corner of the Caravan Park Reserve.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS – 19 OCTOBER 2019

An Ordinary Postal Election will be held on Saturday, 19 October 2019 in the Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup to fill three vacancies each for a four year term. Nominations open on Thursday, 5 September 2019 and close at 4.00pm Thursday, 12 September 2019. More information is included in this edition of the Topics and will follow in the next month.

CONGRATULATIONS

To the Tambellup Hockey Club and their band of volunteers on the successful hosting of the Great Southern Hockey Carnival on 13 and 14 July. The Carnival is rotated around clubs in the Great Southern each year, and attracts many teams from the metro area and across the lower half of the state. We are aware this year around 270 players and more supporters and spectators were accommodated and fed over the course of the weekend – a mammoth effort for the Club and its volunteer base.

On the same weekend the Tambellup Golf Club held its Men's Open Day. Over 60 players nominated for the day, which, as with the hockey, required the coordination of the competition and preparation of morning and afternoon tea, lunch and dinner for all. For our small community it is a credit to our clubs and volunteers that two major club events could be hosted and extremely well run over the same weekend. Well done to all involved.

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Hello,

I'd like the opportunity to introduce myself as the new Sergeant for Tambellup and Broomehill. My family and I are pleased to have moved to the picturesque and historic town of Tambellup. The Great Southern is an amazing part of WA and I look forward to experiencing what it has to offer. I must say it has been a pretty cold start, however we came from an area near Toodyay so we can somewhat relate to the chilly weather, although the days here are colder.

A bit about me, I have a varied work history with WA Police having worked in general duties policing and in recent years as a detective. I've worked regionally in the localities of Northam, South Hedland and Boyup Brook and at various metropolitan stations and specialist units. I came to Tambellup from Major Crash Investigation Section (MCIS) where I investigated serious and fatal crashes state wide. Working at MCIS certainly gave me a different perspective of the impact road trauma has on the community. So please remember to drive safe and take care of each other.

I've been with WA Police for the past 12 years and prior to that was a self-employed carpenter. I see myself as a reasonable and fair minded person and understand that policing a small country community is not the same as policing in the Perth Metropolitan area. In the next few weeks Senior Constable Robert Adamczyk will commence in Tambellup and this will provide the shire with two permanent officers. We will be working a mix of day and afternoon shifts with the Tambellup Police Station occupied intermittently.

In recent weeks there have been a number of burglaries in Broomehill. The offender/s are generally targeting vacant houses, of which there are a few. Although not all burglaries can be avoided, please remain vigilant and consider improving your security wherever possible.

A series of fireworks were set off in Tambellup recently, and while this may seem like a bit of harmless fun it has the potential to pose a safety risk. Please be reminded that it is an offence to possess or set off fireworks without the correct permits.

Prohibited drug use is a problem not only in Tambellup but the whole state. If you have any information that can assist police in tackling this scourge on society you can contact Crime Stoppers anonymously on 1800 333 000 or Tambellup Police directly on 9825 1003.

I look forward to meeting more of you in the coming months and feel free to contact us regarding a police matter or just to say hello.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT POSTAL ELECTION

CLOSE OF ENROLMENTS Friday 30th August 2019

Enrolling to Vote

Local Government Elections are to be held on **Saturday 19 October 2019**. You may be eligible to be enrolled to vote at the election if you reside in or are an owner or occupier of rateable property within the district.

Residents

You are automatically enrolled to vote if you are on the State Electoral roll as at **5.00pm**, **Friday 30 August 2019**. If you are not on the State Electoral roll or have changed your address recently, you must complete an enrolment form.

Non Resident Owners and Occupiers

If you are a non resident owner or occupier of rateable property within the Shire and are on the State or Commonwealth electoral roll, you are eligible to enrol to vote, but must submit a Form 2 - Enrolment Eligibility Claim Form to the local government, as enrolment is not automatic.

A **non resident owner** who was on the last Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup local government roll continues to retain that status as long as the rateable property to which the enrolment relates is owned. An **occupier** does not have continuous enrolment and should contact staff at the Shire to confirm their enrolment status.

If you are not on the State or Commonwealth electoral roll and own or occupy rateable property within the Shire, you may still be eligible to vote. Please contact the Shire for details.

Enrolment Forms - Non Residents and Occupiers

Enrolment Eligibility Claim Forms can be obtained from the Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup and must be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer by **5.00pm, Friday 30 August 2019.**


We also congratulated Dave Herbert on achieving 40 years of continued service to the Tambellup Lions.

New Track Shines for State Round

The 2017 built Sukey Hill track home of Cranbrook Districts Motorcycle Club received good reports from both riders and spectators after hosting the WA Motocross State Round on the 6-7th July. The high light of the day was 16 year old, number 72 rider, Regan Duffy podium speech complementing the club on the track saying that Manjimup will always have history but this track is now a favourite and ready for a national event!

Sukey Hill motocross track is a 1.926km in length (2.061km from start line to finish line) and with a new track speed record of 1 minute and 57 seconds this is an opening and flowing track capitalising on natural terrain which is able to handle the larger 450cc motorbikes. The track surface being a mixture of loam near the start line to clay at Harvey Hill flag point also poses a challenge for riders when selecting their bike tyres.

260 riders competed in the event, which held junior racing on Saturday followed by senior racing on Sunday and 1300 spectators came to view the racing and test out the new pedestrian bridge taking in the high advantage viewing point in the middle of the track.

Another new WA Motocross initiative this year has been live streaming of events by 4Style Riders. This allows people to view the event from the creature comforts of their home or listen to live cometary trackside. Available on 4Style Riders YouTube or Facebook 20,000 people took advantage of this feature. Search 4Style Riders.

Local riders shone in the Amateur Cup class with placing highly contested between local riders Jarrad Smith (Jerramungup), Declan Hepworth (Albany), Jacob Jones (Narrikup). In the Veterans and Masters class Paul Smithson (Kendenup) placed and Barrie Baynes (Broomehill) performed well. Corben Wienert (Albany) placed and Brayden Baynes (Broomehill) competed in the MX2 class, with junior riders Campball McMahnon (Kendenup), Dylan Robinson (Kojonup) and Laura Featherstone Dawes (Albany) also showcasing their talent.

It would have to be said though that the 16 year old WA national senior rider Regan Duffy number 72 rider stole the show, competing in both MX1 and MX2 classes (which were 15 minutes moto plus one lap). He even had time to stop and refuel his bike, then finish first! (scroll to 4:02 hours in live streaming footage)

An event like this draws a large pool of people and sponsors and the club are great full of the support received from, Department of Sport and Recreation Great Southern, Shire of Cranbrook CEO, Councillors & works, Rob & David Wright Water Carting with CC Engineering for Cherry Picker, Hanson Quarry, Elders Cranbrook, Great Southern Mobile Butcher, AA Contractors Frankland River, Harvey & Ann Baxter Bulldozing, Mt Barker Speedway, Cranbrook Golf Club, Cranbrook Town Fire Bridge, Cranbrook Mens Shed, and also the many club members, friends and neighbours who all chipped in to take on an official role on the day and to assist with track preparation. 

New Program: Managing People for Success

In 2019, Meat and Livestock Australia (MLA) and Profitable Grazing Systems (PGS) have partnered with PinG WA to deliver a Supported Learning Program (SLP), which is a producer upskilling program based on supported learning and coaching. PinG WA is set to launch the "Managing People for Success" program this year. The pro-gram focuses on managing people and your business, with four core areas covered: personality profiling, team productivity and time management, industrial relations, and human resources. These topics are covered over several months during off-peak times and include three workshops, two coaching sessions, a touch point and development of a farm-specific project. The structure of this program will allow livestock producers the oppor-tunity to learn by practicing, applying new skills with other producers and to be involved in learning long-term through coaching, peer-to-peer learning and hands-on practice.

Each program is capped at 8-10 farm livestock businesses to ensure effective peer-to-peer learning and coaching sessions. The commercial cost of this program is \$3,150 (+GST) for up to two participants per business. However, with support from MLA's Profitable Grazing Systems this program will be offered at \$1,900 (+GST) per business for up to two participants per business. *That's personality profiling, three workshops, two coaching sessions and a touch point for two people for \$1,900 (+GST) or \$135 pp per session!*

Meat and Livestock Australia (MLA) and Profitable Grazing Systems (PGS) have also supported PinG WA in 2019 to deliver 15 Paperless Farm Office workshops throughout red meat producing regions of WA. The Paperless Farm Office workshops have been extremely popular and well-received, with 99% of participants who attended these workshops stating they would recommend it to their peers.




