The next meeting of Council will be held on Thursday 20th July 2017 commencing at 4.00pm in the Tambellup Council Chambers. Members of the public are welcome to attend all Council meetings.

#### FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING

At the June meeting, Council approved an application for a five metre extension of the NBN telecommunications tower on Lot 542 Reilly Road, subject to conditions. This extension is part of the 'Mobile Black Spot Program', and will improve mobile telecommunications in the Broomehill townsite.

Council prioritised its 2018-2019 Regional Roads Group Project submissions. These included works on the major transport routes in accordance with Council's Roads Hierarchy - Pallinup South Rd, Warrenup Rd, Broomehill-Kojonup Rd, Tambellup West Rd and Toolbrunup Rd. The submissions will be considered and prioritised by the Regional Roads Group along with those from other regional shires. Council considered and approved the specifications for the purchase of a new skid steer in 2017/2018

#### WASTE TRANSFER STATION - PRE PAID TIP CARDS

Residents are reminded that the orange 2016/2017 Waste Transfer Station passes expire on 31 July 2017, and will not be accepted after that date. New passes valid for 2017/2018 will be distributed with rates notices for those residents who do not receive the kerbside rubbish and recycling collections, and prepaid passes will be available to purchase at the Shire Administration offices after 1 July 2017. The purpose of a Waste Transfer Station is to minimise the amount of waste going to landfill, and maximise opportunities for recycling. By sorting your load before you go to the Tip, and making sure your recyclables are clean and uncontaminated, you will be doing your bit to help our environment.

#### TAMBELLUP ST JOHN AMBULANCE

Congratulations to the Tambellup St John Ambulance Sub Centre on the commencement of works to construct a new Sub Centre building on the corner of Norrish and Henry Sts. Demolition of the old building was completed very efficiently and the sand is in place ready for construction to start.

#### **WORKS**

Despite the lack of rain in recent times, our ovals are holding up pretty well. The Broomehill dams are maintaining good levels considering the warmer days we have been having and the lack of rain. The Tambellup Oval is still being reticulated with treated water, with no dam water being used to date. The Broomehill Oval has responded well to top dressing, and both ovals have been sprayed for broadleaf weeds.

Contractors will be in both townsites in coming weeks, carrying out tree pruning under power lines and to improve line of sight on main roads.

Residents in Broomehill will be able to watch the installation of the shade shelter in Holland Park over coming weeks. This is an impressive structure that will provide a full cover to the playground area. The shade sail poles on the southern side of the playground will be relocated into the RSL/Playgroup yard to allow the shade sails to remain in place over the playgroup play equipment.

Work to construct pram ramps in both town centres has commenced. This project has been funded by the Southern Inland Health Initiative.

During May, Main Roads WA signed off on Council's February flood damage estimate of approximately \$3.5 million. The tender for flood damage restoration and the associated drainage works was advertised late in May, with submissions due on 14<sup>th</sup> June. A good response was received, and Council will consider and award the tender at the July Council meeting.

Sealing on Warrenup Rd was completed during June, with some drainage work to be finished off. Contractors have finished off the sealing works on Gnowangerup-Tambellup Rd. The construction crew has been working on Beejenup Rd, carrying out gravel sheeting. The maintenance graders have been working in the north east section of the Shire, moving across to the north west section. Roads graded include: Heron Rd, Norrish Rd, Martinup Rd, Batchelor North Rd, Marshall Rd, Tieline North Rd, Curnow Rd, Graham Rd, Fletcher Rd, Winspear Rd, South Batchelor Rd and Bignell Rd.

#### TAMBELLUP SPORTS PAVILION UPGRADE

As can be seen by the photos included in this edition of the BT Times, the work at the Oval is progressing at a rapid rate as the completion date nears, and this is evident by the amount of hi vis around the site! In the last couple of weeks, the concreting of verandahs and paths has been completed, internal painting has progressed, tiling of wet areas has been completed, installation of floor coverings to the changerooms is finished, car parks have been sealed, kerbed and marked, car park lighting has been installed, the playground area has been defined by a limestone brick wall and excavated ready for backfill, turf has been laid on the terraces and at present the contractor installing the new synthetic bowls surface is on site.

The contractors have advised the practical completion date is estimated to be around mid-July. While this may see the completion of construction on site, there is a period before final handover to the Shire where the facilities will be closely inspected to ensure there are no defects, and if anything requires rectification, the trades will be required to return to site to complete this work. Following formal handover to the Shire, it is planned to coordinate a community busy bee in conjunction with the new Tambellup Community Pavilion Association (TCPA), to complete landscaping and creation of the nature play area. These works will be completed before the facilities are available for use by the public.

While we understand the community is eager to utilise the new facilities, it is important to ensure all aspects of the facilities are complete and working to the required standard before the public has access. We appreciate the understanding and patience of sporting clubs in particular who have been unable to host home fixtures in Tambellup since construction began, however we do need to follow due process to minimise any issues that may inconvenience the users. If clubs need further information in this regard, please feel free to contact Keith or Pam at the Shire.

We would also take this opportunity to remind people that the Pavilion remains a worksite until it is formally handed over to the Shire by the contractors. For safety reasons, access to the site is not available to members of the general public and it would be appreciated if all residents could respect this.

A number of opportunities for the community to view the completed facilities are planned, once the site has been formally handed over to the Shire. A community walkthrough hosted by the TCPA is planned for soon after handover, and on 1 September a formal opening hosted by the Shire will be followed by a community dinner hosted by the TCPA. More information will be available in due course, however at this time the Shire and TCPA ask that you note 1 September on your calendar and plan to come along and celebrate this awesome new facility!



#### RUNDLE WELCOMES NEW FOOD ALLERGY RESOURCE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

Peter Founds MLA, Member for Roe, welcomed the Federal Government 250k initiative a website specifically designed to help resource the 350 000 young Australian's living with severe alternies.

Federal Assistant Minister for Health, Dr David Gilbespie, liumched the www.750b.cm.ml website yesterday, which was funded under the Notional Allergy Strategy.

Mr Rundle said that iverg with severe alregals can be challenging, and research showed that many young Auchalian's felt embatraised discassing their allerges with their peers.

"Managing severe tood ellergies isn't as easy as watching what you eat," Mr Rundle-said.

"Going out for dinner with friends, alteriding parties, going on school camps, travelling, even dating all present challenges for young adults managing their allergies."

The website oftens users to develop their own avatar is communicate with other terragers and young adults iving with severe allergies, sharing tips and real the experiences.

The website also details practical information for young people on how to manage their severe allergy, including recognizing signs and symptoms, using an EpiPan, eating out, distinging responsibility with an ellergy, tips of travelling, dating with an interny and how to manage pariets.

"Parents obviously worry about their children, and the website provides some tips on toers can work with their porents to manage any anisoty surrounding their allergies," Mr Rundle said.

#### Nationals protect regional Local Government from fee hike

The Nationals WA have this week voted to disallow changes to local government vehicle licensing concessions in the Legislative Council.

The disallowance motion will prevent the State Government removing a concession which allowed local governments to pay a lower rate to license their vehicles.

Member for the Agricultural Region Hon Martin Aldridge MLC said the changes would disproportionately harm regional local governments with more vehicles and larger geographic areas to cover.

"As they have to license more vehicles, regional local governments would have borne the brunt of increased vehicle licensing fees," Mr Aldridge said.

"Local governments in my electorate have written to me expressing their concern that rates could rise by up to 10 per cent as a result of this change.

"Given the uncertainty the Labor Government has created around Royalties for Regions, The Nationals want to give local governments certainty around these concessions."

Member for the Agricultural Region Hon Colin de Grussa MLC said the removal of the concession would simply add to the burden of local government, which would be passed on to rate payers.

"Labor Governments have a tendency to neglect regional areas, in particular regional local government," Mr de Grussa said.

'This fee hike on Local Government failed to recognise the role that Local Governments in Western Australia as significant owners and maintainers of the road network.

"Local Governments in my electorate are doing it tough, particularly after a string of natural disaster events which have caused significant damage to the road network which they continue to grapple with."

Mr Aldridge said it was disappointing regional Labor MPs not only support the fee increase, but also tried to prevent the debate on the disallowance before July 1, when the increase was due to take effect.



# Fire safety in your home this winter



#### Fire safety in your home this winter

Every year more than 1,000 fires occur in the home causing millions of dollars damage and costing people their lives. Most deaths occur from smoke and toxic fumes. Sadly, most household fires are accidental and preventable.

Winter sees an increase in fires in the home, often due to an increased need for heating appliances. It is important to be vigilant around your home, particular throughout the winter months.

#### When heating your home

- Always make sure all items are at least a metre from the heater
- Never leave heaters on in bedrooms, especially children's
- Heaters should be checked once a year to make sure they are in working order, worn out electrical cords and plugs should be replaced immediately
- Check your heater, fireplace brickwork, chimney and flue before lighting the first fire of the year to make sure it is clean



- Never leave cooking unattended
- Switch off all kitchen appliances after use
- Avoid wearing loose clothing with big sleeves when cooking as they can catch fire
- Never hang items such as tea towels near stoves or on cooking appliances

#### Home Fire Escape Plan

- Know two ways out of every room
- Decide where your safe meeting place is (outside your home)
- Keep keys in deadlocks to escape quickly in the event of a fire
- Provide alternatives for anyone with a disability
- Consider an escape plan for your pets
- Practise your plan with your family at least twice a year



Never throw water on burning fat or oil, it will explode and the fire will spread

If a fire does start in your home you need to be able to escape as quickly and safely as possible. Having working Smoke Alarms and a Home Fire Escape Pian will increase your chances of getting out of your house safely.

#### In the event of a fire

- □ Crawl low under smoke
- Assist or alert any people in danger, but only if it is safe to do so
- Go to your safe meeting place, such as your letter box
- Call 000 (triple zero)
- Wait for firefighters to arrive
- Do not re-enter a burning house under any circumstances
