The next meeting of Council will be held on Thursday <u>16th March</u> 2017 commencing at 2.00pm in the Tambellup Council Chambers. Members of the public are welcome to attend all Council meetings.

FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING

At the February Council meeting Council endorsed a contribution of \$1,533.00 to the Broomehill Primary School to assist with purchase of a pump and piping for the upgrade of the reticulation system on the school oval and amended the 2016/17 budget accordingly.

Council considered a proposal from the Water Corporation to acquire a portion of the Water Corporation's Jam Creek Dam (Tambellup No 1 Dam), subject to conditions and the determination of final costs for acquisition and an assessment of survey, fencing and subdivision costs.

Council adopted the 2016/2017 Annual Budget Review for the period of 1 July 2016 to 31 January 2017 with amendments made to the annual budget as required.

Council endorsed the Electoral Commissioner to be responsible for the conduct of the 2017 ordinary elections together with any other elections or polls which may be required and decided that in accordance with section 4.61(2) of the *Local Government Act 1995* that the method of conducting the election will be as a postal election.

ANNUAL ELECTORS MEETING

The Annual Electors meeting held on the 8th December 2016 saw a small turnout of interested electors. Matters discussed included the Transfer Stations and Restricted Access Vehicle (RAV) Rating. The minutes of the meeting and the Shire's 2015-2016 Annual Report are available for perusal at the Shire Administration offices, and also on Council's website www.shirebt.wa.gov.au.

WORKS

Coring and top dressing of the Broomehill oval is booked for the end of February, at the close of the cricket season and spraying for broadleaf will be carried out in March. There have been ongoing issues with the pump and sprinklers at the Tambellup oval, with a lot of sprinklers being replaced.

WANDRRA drainage crew are replacing the culvert on Anderson Road. Pipes have been ordered for the main culvert on Pallinup South Road. Once delivered in early March they will be installed by the WANDRRA drainage drew.

Maintenance graders are currently repairing roads on priority. There are a number of sections that have broken up during harvest and need gravel sheeting to repair them. The Jetpatcher is carrying out repairs on the bitumen network. There are a number of roads which require stabilizing and sealing to repair failures and they include Toolbrunup, Tie Line, Tambellup West, Gnowangerup-Tambellup and Broomehill-Kojonup roads.

The State Government is cutting concessional registrations to local governments. This has a secondary effect as stamp duty then applies to local governments when registering new vehicles and plant. The biggest impact will be stamp duty on light vehicles.

The new Caterpillar Roller has arrived and is now in use. Information was presented to Council regarding Jetpatchers and the benefit in having an automotive unit compared to a manual type unit that is towed by a truck. The Jetpatcher has three unit sizes in the range.

PROHIBITED AND RESTRICTED BURNING PERIOD

All residents of the Broomehill-Tambellup Shire are reminded that the **RESTRICTED BURNING PERIOD** commenced on **15 FEBRUARY 2017** and continues through until **15 APRIL 2017**. During this period you are required to obtain a permit prior to lighting any fires. Conditions noted on the permit must be strictly complied with. Permits can be obtained from your Brigade Fire Control Officer, or the Community Emergency Services Manager (CESM), Cindy Pearce. Please contact the Shire on 98253555 for more information. Please note, the lighting of fires is **PROHIBITED** during the Easter period **14-17 APRIL 2017.**

HARVEST BANS

Harvest is complete, but the risk of fire is still present, and all residents are reminded Council has a number of ways in which it communicates information relating to harvest and vehicle movement bans:


- SMS to your mobile phone: Is your mobile number registered with the Shire to receive this information? If not, or you need to update your information please contact Kim at the Shire on 9825 3555. (On a similar note if you no longer wish to receive these notifications please contact Kim and your number will be removed from the list.) Please be aware there are a number of mobile reception black spots in the Shire and this may result in delivery of messages being delayed. Do not rely on SMS as your only source of information.
- Radio broadcasts: Every effort is made to ensure details of harvest and vehicle movement bans are provided to RadioWest and ABC radio for broadcast, however the timing of bans being implemented often means cut off times for broadcast can be missed. ABC radio (as the emergency broadcaster) has advised the following designated times for announcement of bans: Weekdays 10.05am, 12.35pm and 2.05pm

Weekends - 12.35pm, 2.05pm.

 Harvest Ban Hotline: Phone 98251042 for updated information relating to the status of a harvest and vehicle movement ban. This is the most reliable source of information from the Shire.

Total Fire Bans and Harvest and Vehicle Movement Bans affect every resident of the Shire, whether you are in town or on a farm. The onus is on you as an individual to keep an eye on the weather conditions if you are using machinery or tools in your yard or the paddock. Stop work, step out of the machine at regular intervals, monitor weather forecasts, talk to your neighbours, and contact your brigade Fire Control Officer if you are concerned. Let's be safe this summer!



CRANBROOK MOTORCROSS

Club move goes up a gear.

Cranbrook Districts Motorcycle Club has received \$200,000 to help the club relocate to its new home at the Sukey Hill Regional Motorcycling Facility.

Development of this project will be unique to the Great Southern Region, as it will include an enduro, trial and motocross track at the one venue, as well as being available to surrounding motorcycling clubs to utilise. The motocross track designed by well-known coach Greg Moss, is being constructed to Australian National standards with the unique spectator feature of the ability to walk the whole perimeter.


The funding was announced in Cranbrook on 31st January 2017 by Nationals Tuck Waldron in conjunction with the Great Southern Development Commission. It was part of the State Government Royalties for Regions scheme, which address the inequities between the country and the city. This scheme funding helps community, public and not for profit organisations fund smaller community driven projects that make a real difference in the regions.

Club president Justin Shepherd said this has been a joint effort between the club and the Shire of Cranbrook which will benefit the town of Cranbrook and further reach residents of the Great Southern. He also acknowledged the Government for giving our club Cranbrook DMCC this opportunity to promote the sport of motocross, enduro and trials in the region. And also those who have driven this unique project; Cranbrook Community, Cranbrook DMCC Committee, motocross

fraternity, the shire councillors, Club Development Officer Nicole Sewsale, Recreation Officer Toni Melia, and CEO Peter Northover.

Cranbrook DMCC will use the \$200,000 to fund Stage 1 – being the relocation of the motocross club from Rockwell Flats to the more suitable Sukey Hill. It will include the construction of a bike waiting bay, scrutineering/first aid hut and motocross track. The club will source further funds to assist with Stage 2 – being construction of dam and track sprinklers, and Stage 3 – being construction of a clubhouse.


