

The next meeting of Council will be held on Thursday <u>21st July 2016</u> commencing at 4.00pm in the Tambellup Council Chambers. Members of the public are welcome to attend all Council meetings.

#### FROM THE COUNCIL MEETING

The June agenda carried a heavy governance focus, with Council considering new and reviewed policies, Business Continuity plans for the Shire, planning applications, appointment of dual Fire Control Officers for neighbouring shires, and reviews of ongoing third party agreements.

Council also endorsed the reviewed Local Emergency Management Arrangements. This document sets out arrangements that are in place between the Shire and other agencies, which would be implemented in the event of a major emergency impacting the Shire. The Arrangements were reviewed and endorsed by the Local Emergency Management Committee at its May meeting, and following Councils endorsement, will be in place for a further five year period. Copies of the Arrangements are available for public perusal at both Shire Administration offices and the Tambellup CRC.

Council supported a proposal for a Tandem Drive Concessional RAV 6 Level 3 rating to be applied on Tambellup West

Road (from Great Southern Highway to the Shire of Kojonup boundary), and Gnowangerup Tambellup Road (from the Gnowangerup Shire boundary to Great Southern Highway), subject to conditions. Main Roads WA will carry out the required assessment and advise their decision in due course.

Following the close of the advertised inspection period for the Silent Auction held to dispose of equipment at the Tambellup Sports Pavilion, Council considered the bids received. All successful and unsuccessful bidders have been notified. Thank you to all who took part in this process.

Council held its draft budget meeting on 20 June, to consider the preliminary 2016-2017 annual budget. It is anticipated the budget will be adopted on 14<sup>th</sup> July, with rate notices being issued at the end of July.

#### **ROAD SAFETY CONFERENCE 2016**

The Shire was represented at the 2016 Road Safety Conference held in Cranbrook during June.

Presenters included the Regional Superintendent of Police, who provided an update on traffic policing priorities and trends in the region, as well as an analysis of the data relating to crashes resulting in serious injuries and fatalities in the Great Southern region over the past twelve months. Sadly, from time of preparing his presentation to the morning of the conference, the road toll had increased yet again. From the analysis it appears driver inattention has been a major contributing factor in many of the fatalities in our region this year, with speed and alcohol also featuring highly.

Other presenters included Kim Papalia, Commissioner for the Road Safety Commission, Andrew Duffield from Main Roads WA, and Roadwise committees from the region.

#### **WASTE TRANSFER STATION – PRE PAID TIP CARDS**

Residents are reminded that the blue 2015-2016 Waste Transfer Station passes expire on 31 July 2016, and will not be accepted after that date. New passes valid for 2016-2017 will be distributed with rates notices for those residents who do not receive the kerbside rubbish and recycling collections, and prepaid passes will be available to purchase at the Shire Administration offices after 1 August 2016. To Cr Trevor Prout, on being awarded an Order of Australia medal as part of the Queen's Birthday Honours this year. Trevor's award is for service to Local Government and the community of Tambellup. The award is due recognition of Trevor's long term commitment to many local clubs and organisations in our community. Congratulations Trevor!

#### **TAMBELLUP SPORTS PAVILION UPGRADE**

Following the awarding of the contract to construct the new building and bowling green to Wauters Enterprises and Evergreen Synthetic Grass respectively, work commenced late in June to demolish the Pavilion. This turned out to be a very quick process, with the company engaged to complete demolition proving to be very adept at their craft!





We have been advised the construction will take at least 12 months to complete. As residents will expect, the site has been cordoned off with security fencing. Builders on site at the new CEO house in Tambellup have recently experienced issues with children and other people deliberately causing damage at the site; these incidents have been reported to Police. In an effort to ensure the construction of the Pavilion and bowling green is hassle free, it would be sincerely appreciated if parents and care givers could monitor the movements of their children to keep them away from the building site at the Oval.

#### **WORKS**

In response to the waterlogging problems being experienced at the Broomehill Oval, Sussex Turf from Busselton has completed soil profiling across the oval to determine the most appropriate treatment option. Thanks to the recent rains, all Shire dams in Broomehill and Tambellup that are used to reticulate ovals, parks and gardens are full, which will provide great benefit over the summer. On the flip side, the rains have kept Council's parks and gardens staff busy mowing and weeding! Some pruning of street trees under powerlines has been completed.

An electrician has been working to repair the bollard lights along the railway path in Broomehill which are not working at present.

The construction crew has been busy during June, working on funded road works projects including gravel sheeting on Norrish Rd and Pallinup South Rd. A couple of carry over funded jobs from 2015-2016 will be prioritised for completion early in the new financial year, being gravel sheeting on Beejenup Rd and Punchmirup North Rd.

A contractor has been carrying out vegetation widening on Mattiske Rd, and will be moving over to Beejenup Rd when works are complete.

The maintenance graders have been working in the north west part of the Shire, and also the north east to tidy some roads impacted by rain. Roads graded were old Broomehill Kojonup Rd, Etna Rd,

Nookanellup Rd, North Nookanellup Rd, Batchelor North Rd, Tieline North Rd, Curnow Rd, Thompson Rd, Warrenup Rd, Holding Rd and South Batchelor Rd.

Grading of bitumen edges on sealed roads will be completed when weather conditions allow.

In recognition of individual excellence in public service, Joanne recently received the Local Government Leader of the Year Award at the 2016 IPAA WA Achievement Awards conducted at the Hyatt Regency, Perth. Joanne has worked in rural local government for over 27 years, 17 of those as a Chief Executive Officer and was responsible for leading the councils of Broomehill and Tambellup through an amalgamation process to become the Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup in 2008. Locally,

Joanne's major achievements include involvement in the establishment of a bank franchise, gaining of funding for the provision of seniors housing and \$3.6m for a new recreation facility at Tambellup. At a sector level, Joanne has served on the Local Government Advisory Board, Minister's Advisory Committee on Women in Local Government and the Western Australian Local Government Association's Country

Reform Policy Forum. At a regional level, Joanne was heavily involved in the formation of the Southern Link Voluntary Regional Organisation of Councils which has seen nearly \$4.7m worth of funded infrastructure delivered to the member councils.
