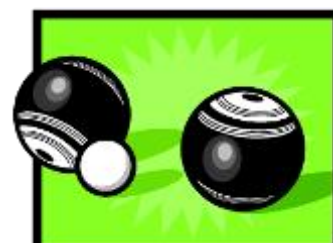

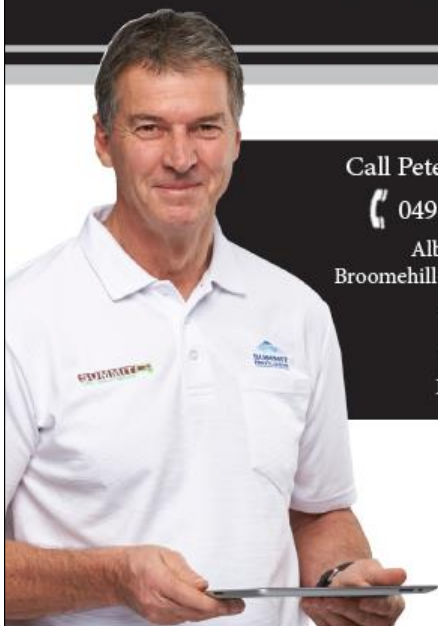

New Bushfire Prone Areas Cover 90% of the State.

The Western Australian Government has released new building and planning requirements for those homes being built in a Bushfire Prone Area commencing the 8th April 2016.

Bushfire Prone Areas do include homes within town sites across the State.

A Bushfire Prone Area identifies those areas of the State that are likely to be subject to a bushfire attack. Where a bushfire prone area cuts across a portion of land, the entire parcel is considered to be bushfire prone.

Property owners that already have dwellings in an area now declared “Bushfire Prone” need to be aware that your current home insurance may not cover a rebuild under the new standards required if your dwelling was destroyed.

Broomehill Historical Notes

Quite a few years ago Shirley MacDonald began to work through the diaries of her Grandfather, Thomas Norrish (TN) which he wrote when he first came to Eticup to take up farming and the diaries of William Henry Graham (WHG) who was also one of the first pioneers of the Eticup district. Shirley collated all the information both in alphabetical and chronological order. There are many wonderful pieces of information and anecdotes in these diaries and we are proud to share them with the community each month.

Yambungate, Billie – Aboriginal. On the 18th January 1882, TN heard that Yambungate was back after serving three or four years for killing another native about three years before.

Yankee Jack – Unidentified. On 20th December 1862, WHG saw Yankee Jack driving Solomon Drolf's team and shortly afterwards noticed smoke near Wadeganup which proved to be from a fire lit by Yankee Jack. On 12th January 1863, WHG attended the Court in Albany about Yankee Jack's burning of Wageganup; Jack was fined £5.

Yelung, Billie – Aboriginal. On 12th April 1883 he and Dina arrived at Goblup with 50 wethers from Churchill's flock. On 18th May 1884, Duncan told TN that Billie Yelung had died at Mungrup.

Young, John William – Member of the Goblup shearing team in 1879; he and other shearers had finished at Fairfield. He was back again in 1880 with his brother Henry and on 26th October they spent the day shearing for Patrick Carmody. In 1881 John, Henry and Andrew Young were shearing at Goblup. John and Andrew returning in 1882. John purchased 406 ewes, 30 culls and 6 rams from TN and started with them for Albany on 2nd November 1882.

John Young was the son of David and Margaret (nee Muir) of Marbellup, Wilson's Inlet. He married Christen Norrish's sister Martha Wray in 1883.

When the "Bacchante", on its way to the eastern colonies in 1881, was diverted to Albany for rudder repairs, the Royal passengers, Prince Albert and George (later George V) stayed with the Young's at Marbellup for two days, and, at the Ball given by Mr Hassell, John's future wife, Martha Wray, was one only two single ladies whom the Princes danced with; Martha danced with George.

On 25th April 1892, Martha Young came to Goblup to stay for a while and John joined her on 1st June. On the 10th he went with TN to Boylup and helped make drafting yards for the Chinese. He and Martha returned to Albany on 16th June.

In 1898, widowed John Young spent most of the year at Goblup, helping TN and others with various farm jobs including shearing at Sunnyside. On 1st July he returned to Albany after attending the Ball that had been held for the opening of the new Broome Hill Hall (now Museum). He came back again on 27th August, accompanying TN's daughter Hannah. On 4th November John went to the Kojonup Show with the Norrish family and R.H. Jones and on 12th December he was at Roundwood and went with TN and W.P. Wray to Burrridge's. On 19th October 1897, TN visited John Young in Albany and commented on his looking very thin.

Tambellup project helps spread road safety message

A Tambellup project will help the State Government spread its important road safety message, being granted \$600 during the Christmas New Year period.

In a timely reminder during the festive season, the local grant was one of 12 for WA groups, which shared in \$104,000 and each clearly promoted road safety.

Member for Wagin Terry Waldron MLA said the Tambellup Twilight Tunes project, an annual community event to raise funds for the St John Ambulance – Tambellup Sub Centre, received the grant through the Road Safety Community Grants initiative.

Mr Waldron said road safety was paramount and that each and every one of us must be accountable for our actions while driving.

"As drivers, we all have a responsibility for road safety and it is vital that the message be spread to help reduce further road trauma," Mr Waldron said.

The recently funded projects include a 'Share the Roads' education program targeting cyclists, motorcycle riders and drivers in the Great Southern.

Mr Waldron said the majority of the recipients were based in regional WA.

He said \$360,000 was available for community grants in 2015-16.

Submissions for the next round of grants close on February 5, 2016.

Twenty million Royalties for Regions community grants opening soon

The latest round of funding for the Royalties for Regions Regional Grants Scheme (RGS) and the Community Chest Fund (CCF) will see a total of \$20 million made available to small and large community projects across regional WA.

Applications for the RGS and the CCF will open on Monday, January 11, 2016 and close on Thursday, March 17, 2016.

Member for Wagin Terry Waldron MLA encouraged communities in the Wagin electorate to consider putting forward applications for funding.

"Royalties for Regions investment is continuing to improve services and grow communities in regional WA, and these two funding streams are excellent opportunities to get much-needed funding for local initiatives," Mr Waldron said.

The RGS is aimed at bigger projects, which help attract investment, increase job opportunities and improve the quality of life in the regions, with grants ranging from \$50,001 to \$300,000. The CCF supports smaller local projects, with one-off grants of up to \$50,000.

"Hundreds of diverse projects and organisations across regional WA have benefited from these grants in recent years," Mr Waldron said.

In 2015, Mr Waldron announced a number of local projects that received funding through the RGS and the CCF. Some of the CCF grants include –

- \$20,000 for thermal pool blankets for the Boddington Swimming Pool
- \$18,574 awarded to the local Rural Living Expo 2015
- Two \$10,000 grants (a total of \$20,000) was approved for the Hotham-Williams Economic Development Alliance

WA's nine Regional Development Commissions will oversee the successful projects, with \$15 million available under the RGS and \$5 million under the CCF for the 2016 calendar year.

Minister for Regional Development Terry Redman has announced a 50 per cent increase to both funding streams. Each Regional Development Commission will have access to \$1.67 million for the RGS and \$556,000 for the CCF.

"These grant programs support region-specific priorities that are driven by local communities to assist the development of infrastructure, services and community projects intended to build vibrant regions with strong economies," Mr Redman said.

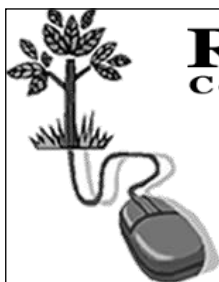

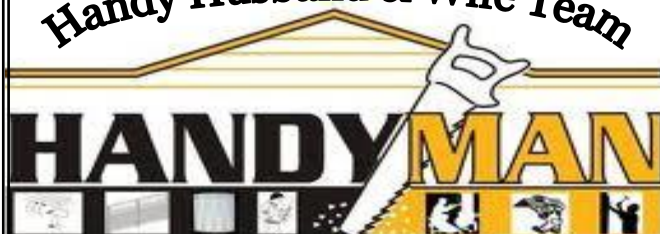
