FROM THE DECEMBER COUNCIL MEETING

The Annual Electors Meeting will be held on Thursday 6th February 2014 at 7.30pm in the Tambellup Council Chambers. Copies of the Annual Report are available at both the Broomehill and Tambellup offices.

At the December Council meeting the development of a new Local Planning Strategy to replace the current Shire of Broomehill Town Planning Scheme and Shire of Tambellup Town Planning Scheme continued, with Council considering the final draft of the document following input from the Department of Planning. The document will now be submitted to the Western Australian Planning Commission/Department of Planning for approval to advertise for public comment for a period of 42 days. Copies of the document will be made available to the public at both the Broomehill and Tambellup offices, once it is advertised.

With works ongoing at both the Tambellup and Broomehill Rubbish Tips to complete the transition to manned Waste Transfer Stations, a number of matters relating to public access were considered. More information will be made available to residents closer to the completion of works. Initially, Council has endorsed the opening times for the Broomehill and Tambellup Waste Transfer Stations:

- Thursdays and Fridays from 1.00pm to 4.30pm;
- Sundays from 10.00am to 4.00pm; and
- Mondays from 8.00am to 1.00pm

and that the opening hours be reviewed as part of the annual budget process.

Council also endorsed the implementation of the Tip Pass system for the Broomehill and Tambellup Waste Transfer Stations, whereby passes containing a number of tokens are available:

- a one off annual distribution to residents with no weekly rubbish collection; and
- for sale to residents who receive a weekly rubbish collection and residents requiring additional access to the Waste Transfer Stations.

Each token will have a face value to be determined by Council as part of the annual budget process. Fees and charges relating to the operations of the Broomehill and Tambellup Waste Transfer Stations will be advertised in accordance with Section 6.19 of the Local Government Act 1995.

Council endorsed the *Appointment of Bush Fire Control Officers* policy which states mandatory training will be required for Chief, Deputy and Brigade Fire Control Officers in order for their nomination to these positions to be endorsed by Council.

In accordance with Occupational Safety and Health legislation, Council has a duty of care to all its brigade volunteers to provide as safe a working environment as possible. This extends to ensuring Fire Control Officers are appropriately skilled to manage a fire incident, and the volunteers assisting at the incident.

The requirement for officers to complete appropriate training will assist in meeting this duty of care, and will ensure the people appointed to these positions are appropriately qualified to manage a fire incident. It is timely that DFES has advised they will be conducting a Fire Control Officers course in Jerramungup on 14th March 2014. Brigade members wishing to nominate, particularly anyone who may be stepping up to the role of Fire Control Officer for the next fire season, are asked to contact Kim at the Shire for more information. Nominations close on Wednesday 26 February 2014.

We appreciate feedback as to the condition of the roads, and ask for your patience as the graders work to address the issues. In the meantime, please consider the condition of the roads you are travelling on, and drive according to the conditions.

TAMBELLUP INDEPENDENT LIVING SENIORS UNITS

Work at the Units site stopped for a couple of weeks over Christmas and New Year, but the crew are now back onsite and the building is progressing. All house pads were laid early in December and the timber framing was erected prior to Christmas. These tasks were completed within a very short period, providing a real 'wow' factor. After so many years of working to secure the funding for the project, it is exciting to see the development take place so rapidly.





WOULD UP TO \$200 PER CHILD HELP PAY FOR THEIR SPORTING CLUB FEES?

KidSport will assist <u>eliqible</u> families to receive up to \$200 annually for each of their children aged between 5 – 18 years, to subsidise fees to join a sport and recreation club. Eligible families include those with health care cards or pension concession cards, or those referred by other community groups such as schools, juvenile justice teams, government agencies and health practitioners. These groups are known as referral agents.

The process for accessing KidSport is simple!

Kids and parents/guardians can complete the application by picking one up from the Shire of Broomehill-Tambellup office or their website. The parent/guardian fills in the application and takes it to be validated at the <u>local government they reside in</u>. A photocopy of the health care card or pension concession card must be attached.

Alternatively, referral agents may assist in filling out the application, complete their section on the back and give it to the parent/guardian to sign. The parent/guardian will take the voucher to the sport or recreation club for processing when registering their children. The club will then invoice the Shire. It's that easy! - To find out who the Referral Agents are in your community please contact the Shire.
